## TORY LEADER OF STEADFAST HONOR

Haultain Will Not Sacrifice Principle to Party Expediency.

When the Conservative convention was held in Saskatchewan a few days ago says the Winnipeg Tribune, it was noted that the name of the leader of the party in that province, Mr. F. W. G. 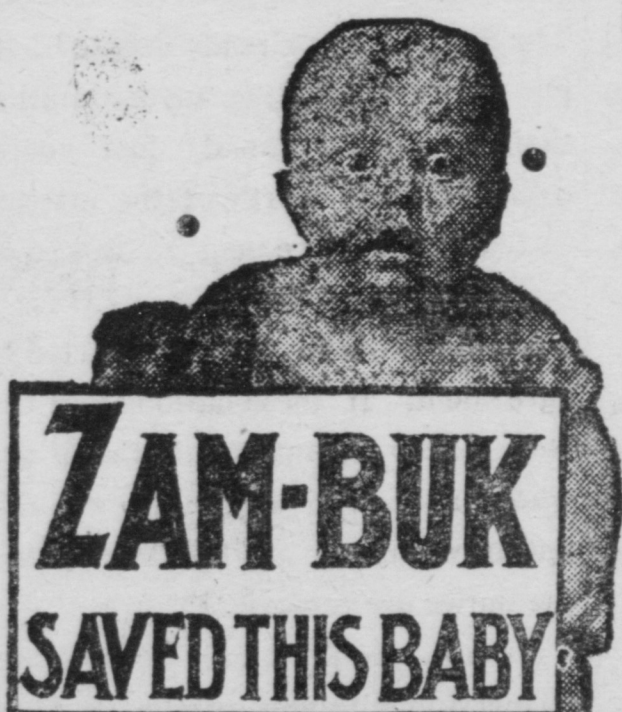

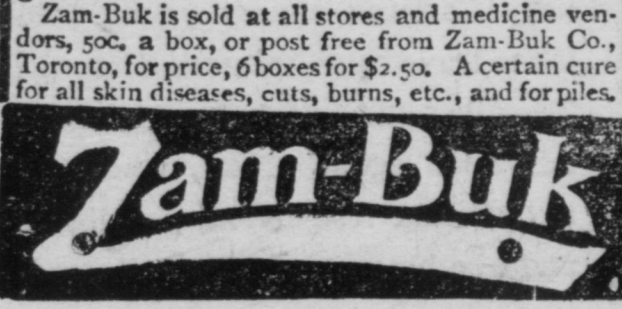
