#### FORESTRY IN EUROPE

The productive forest area in 1908 on the Grand Duchy of Hesse in Europe amounted to 182,263 acres. In general the standing timber is composed of sixtynine percent hardwood and thirty one percent coniferous species. The total yield of lumber in 1908 was 4,375,000 cubic feet. Refuse in so far as it is not suitable for lighter lumber, such as laths or for pulp, is used for firewood. The expenditures for salaries, forest cultivation and road building amounted to approximately \$754,000, and the total gross income (from lumber and firewood) was \$1,161,931.
