

No doubt the Flemming scheme would be generally satisfactory, if the Department of Agriculture, would care for all the orchards the farmers planted, and there is just as much reason why it should look after the young orchards of the farmers as to perform such a service for members of the Board of Trade; more reason in fact, for the farmers might learn something by watching the Provincial horticulturists at work, while it is pretty safe to say the Board of Trade members will not visit their orchards often enough to learn a great deal.




