

# Landry "Malpractice" in Department of Agriculture

## A Course in Trimming Whiskers Qualifies Poultry Expert—Carleton County Don't Get a Look-in at Apple Show—Systematic Campaign of Graft by Landry and His Gang—The Best Apple County in Province Sacrificed by Unscrupulous Politicians

New Brunswick Agriculture and the innocence that there never was any Fleming Government.

We ought to say "mis-government." Now what did these high minded If ever the crooked work of the patriots who by a turn of the wheel of fortune do when they woke from their surprise to find themselves actually "in power." Landry and Hubbard, on division of spoils, decided they would first learn something about agriculture. Result, a junket trip under the name of an Agricultural Commission, costing the province thousands of dollars. They learned a whole lot. First, that a proper course for poultry instruction experts was a course trimming whiskers. They gathered a lot of facts from farmers, and it made a large book. The idea was good, for Canada was waking up to the need of more for agriculture and fruit growing and for immigration. Fruit growing looked good. It would attract the better class of British farmer-immigrants—and investors in "fruit lands." It was next necessary to provide the "apple lands." There were thousands of acres of the best in this County, but it was necessary to find "apple lands" nearer the flat "interval" and popple lands of Fredericton and St. John, and near towns engaged in manufacturing poultry experts and "commissioners" for the new era of "prosperity" which was going to make up by liberal expenditure of hot air, printers ink, and public money. We believe they ventured to launch their "new policy" on the strength of the success of this county in agriculture and horticulture. They therefore hired a "horticulturist" from Ontario. Landry, Hubbard & Co., at every public occasion informed the worthy electorate that this lucky "find" certainly "knew his business." In other words he got quickly "onto his job." He costs us sixteen hundred a year and expenses. They got up a big apple show, the air was blue with "hot air," printers ink was spread all over from England to Ontario telling how the "Hazen Government" had just discovered what the people of Eastern Canada had never found out before that New Brunswick was a great place to raise apples. The show astonished a good many people up this way, for they never heard about the show until they saw it in the papers. The Government, according to the figures in the Auditor General's report, spent upwards of \$1900 dollars buying apples, packing them in boxes, painting placards and advertising signs, photographs, printing and advertising, cartage, and large amounts unspecified to "Various Persons."—AND CARLETON COUNTY NEVER HAS AS MUCH AS A LOOK-IN AT THIS SHOW. Visitors from the County went there and came away ashamed of their county. THEY DID NOT KNOW that this was the opening move in a systematic campaign to exploit alleged apple lands and other opportunities for graft in the sections of New Brunswick represented for the time being by Landry and his gang of hungry grafters. They had never raised apples, and they never will except from free nursery trees given by the Government in the disguise of being "illustration orchards." Last year, the show was better. On account of a big kick raised on account of the previous show and other things, after the "horticulturist" had, in pursuance of a campaign of systematic misrepresentation, taken on himself the serious task of publishing articles in the public press about the marsh lands between Fredericton and St. John being "New Brunswick's Premier Apple Lands" and no mention of this county, and the formation of a Company, at Burton composed of Secretary Hubbard's brother and others close to the Government to plant and sell off blocks of "apple lands" to settlers from the Old Country—this was more than the fruit growers of this county could stand and the Carleton County Fruit Growers Association was formed, entered a polite but energetic protest with the Commissioner—which communication

was haggled over and finally never answered—but got a good space for an exhibit from this county, so the public could have for the first time an idea of the extensive business carried on ahead of all the province. But the misrepresentation has gone right on uninterrupted. Thousands of nursery trees have been imported by the Government and distributed in all sections of the lower province free of charge. This list was not in the Horticultural Report but was forced by G. W. Upham in reply to questions put on the floor of parliament, and shows 7500 apple trees costing 21 and 22 cents wholesale, distributed to 63 places, of which but three are in this county, and those three, it is understood bought and paid for their trees, the Government admitting in their written reply that this whole list is "Practically all illustration orchards," therefore free to the planters. Look for the party heeler you will find them all there. Another significant and peculiar feature. The Government admits getting these trees from a certain list of New York and Ontario firms, well enough known in the first Horticultural Report, the "expert" discovers that all the dissatisfaction over nursery trees growing is the "travelling salesman" and he WARNS, NOT TO BUY OF THEM. Now the same firms have travelling agents all over the Province. One of these firms, a well known Ontario concern, has we have been reliably informed by an agent himself, that if the public are in doubt about the quality of the trees offered, THEY ARE REFERRED TO THE HORTICULTURIST OF NEW BRUNSWICK. The mask, however, is falling off. Their hand has been made clear.

Investors are directed to the "premier apple section", where the Horticulturist has been preparing detailed "orchard land surveys" for that admitted purpose. But the mask is off. They have got the advertising, they have got their free orchards, and that is all they were working for. The "expert" whose information was at the very outset seen to be either grossly imperfect or else deliberately one-sided may be seen now in his true place, by anyone who will take the trouble to look over the last agricultural report. He is established with a new orchard of 1600 trees, at Upper Burton, Sunbury Co., no great ways, we may be sure, from the "Premier apple lands", he misused his office to advertise, and not far from his very good friends Hubbard, Slipp & Co.

Carleton County has been stripped bare and naked, and never have Fleming or Munro, our representatives, lifted a voice nor raised a hand in protest. They have been treacherous to even their own lifelong supporters. The fruit inspectorship for New Brunswick was promised for this County to a life long Conservative and party worker well qualified for the position. Instead, a down-river time server gets it, at \$1500 a year. They took means in an underhand and dishonorable way to beat this county out of any re-

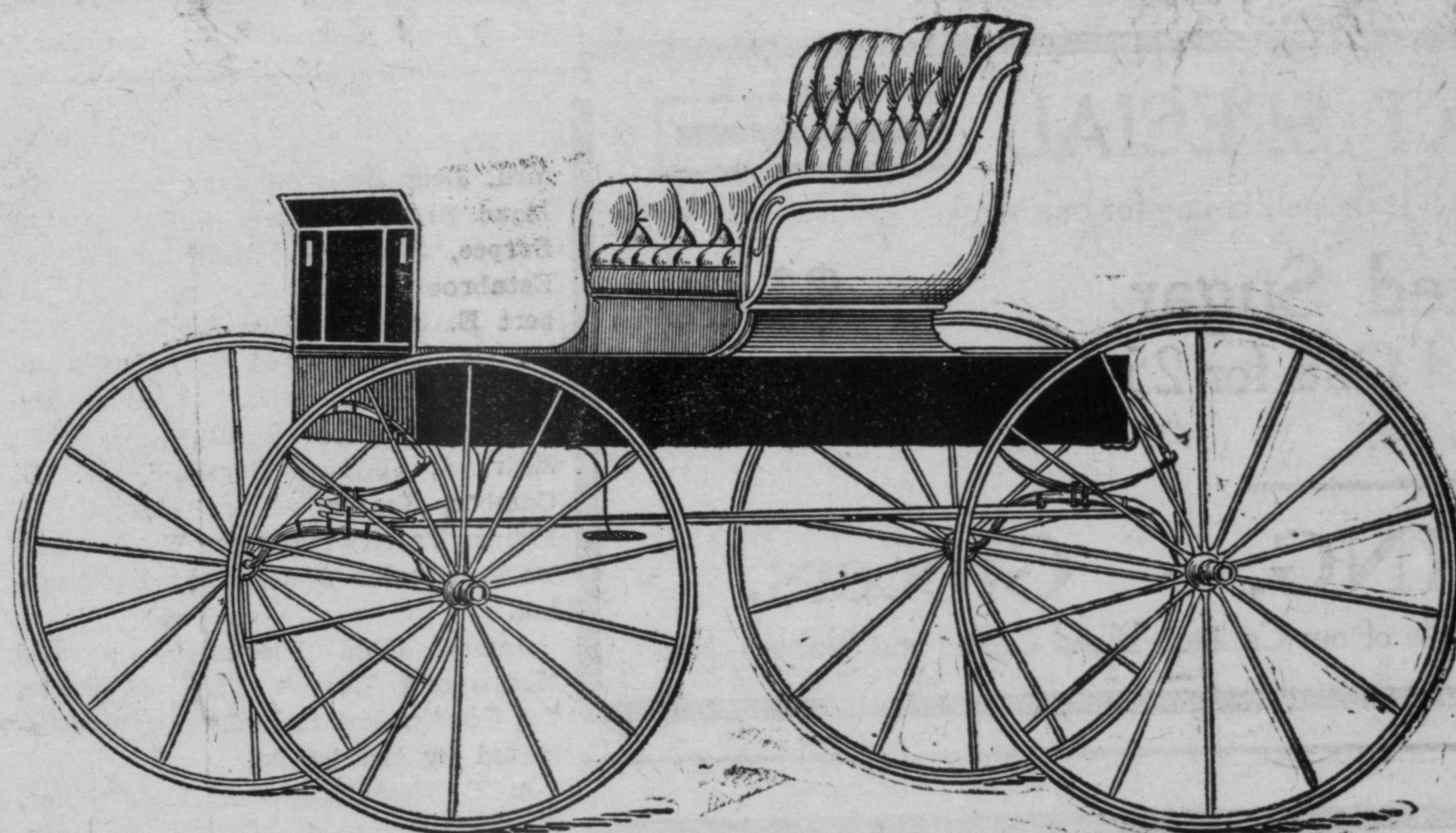

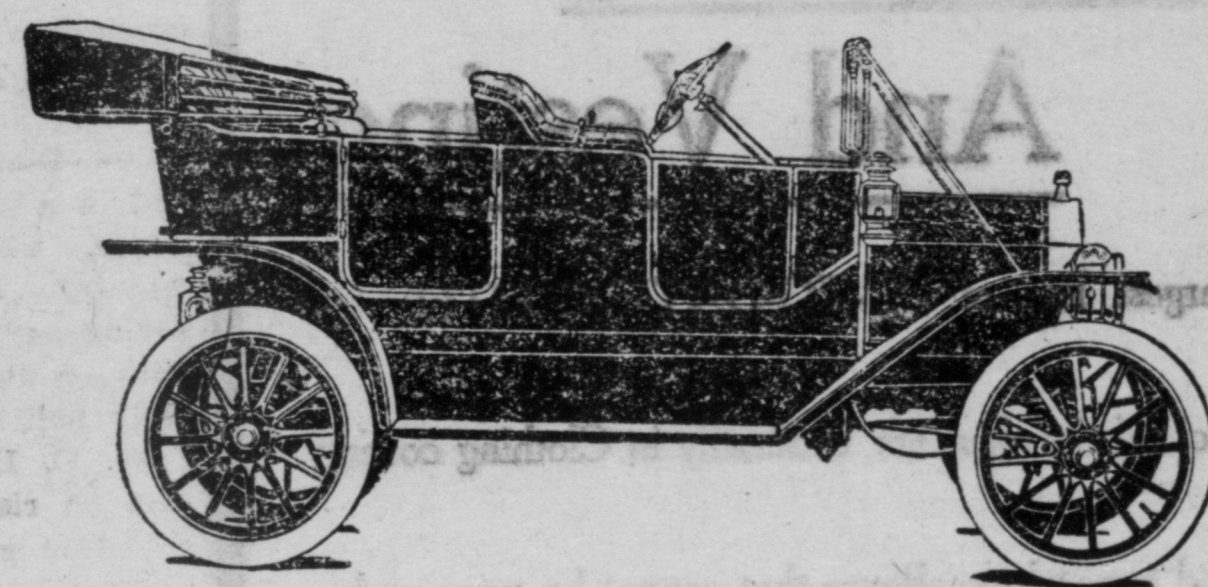
