Were the Wrong Men

Sent to England?

The Toronto Star (Ind. Liberal) says under the heading "Were the wrong men sent?"—"It is stated in a despatch from London that there is some difference of opinion in the Asquith Cabinet as to whether it is good policy to send Mr. Churchill to Canada with a squadron of warships to assist this country in deciding upon a naval policy.

"It is to be hoped that there is some such difference of opinion, and

that Mr. Churchill will be dissuaded from making this characteristic piece of stage-play. In the Asquith Cabinet it is the Liberalism of Mr. Lloyd George rather than the Winstonism of Mr. Churchill that appeals to the imagination of reformers around the world.

"In this country there is some difference of opinion as to the length we should go in naval policy. There is a desire—there is a well-warranted anxiety—among the leaders of both political parties to compose these differences and evolve a program which will be creditable to our position in the Empire without causing

discord in the Dominion. The problem is one that only familiar hands should touch.

"If the First Lord of the Admiralty comes here with a squadron of warships, the visit will have the appearance of being designed to influence Canada's action. The visit will create the impression that what we do is not voluntary, but that pressure has been put upon us as a people. All the wild sayings of the Nationalists of Quebec in their campaign to defeat Laurier on the navy question last autumn will be given a color of truth which they never possessed for a moment, and can never possess. The visit will create the impression that in doing what we would do anyway, pressure was put upon us. The feather that Mr. Borden would wear in his cap, young Mr. Churchill will wear home. Quebec will look on with misgivings. Americans in the Western Provinces will conclude that the extent of our self-government is not what we would have them believe, and that Britain's attitude of non-interference in our affairs, of which we boast, is but a fiction.

"It must be deemed an unfortunate thing if the Government of Canada, represented in London by the Prime Minister and two or three of his colleagues, could not sufficiently discuss naval matters with the Admiralty to satisfy the requirements of those of their colleagues who remained at home. These Ministers crossed the ocean to discuss this subject on behalf of the Government.

"Were the wrong men sent? Or why should it be necessary for Mr. Churchill to return with the messengers who were sent to him?"
