### Training Boys For the Land in Australia

In South Australia special efforts are made, says the Standard of Empire, to counteract the modern tendency of young men to crowd into the cities rather than engage in farming pursuits. In this connection the Government has for some time past had under consideration the establishment of a training farm for boys, with the object of providing for the city youth who is inclined to go upon the land, but whose parents are not in a position to assist him to fit himself for such work. Last week the Minister of Industry and Agriculture announced that the arrangements for carrying the scheme into effect had been practically completed.

The new training farm will be situated on the North Boigorowie Estate, 100 miles north of Adelaide. Boys from 14 to 16 years of age are eligible for admission, and may stay at the farm for two years, or until they reach the age of 17, which is the maximum age at which a boy can remain in residence. They will be provided with board and lodging, clothes, and an allowance of 1s per week for pocket-money, and, in addition, providing their conduct is satisfactory, a bonus of £2 10s per half-year will be paid into the Savings Bank to the credit of their respective accounts. During their stay at the farm the lads will receive an elementary training in all branches of farm work, including the cultivation of cereals, the care of sheep and poultry, and the handling of cows.

## SOMETHING WRONG HERE

Hon. Frank Cochrane Makes Statement in Parliament re Valley Ry.

SAYS ROAD WILL BE BUILT FROM PARISH OF ANDOVER TO A POINT IN VICINITY OF ST. JOHN.

Ottawa, March 2.—At 1 o'clock this morning, just as the house was adjourning, Hon. Mr. Pugsley asked what progress was being made with the contract for the Valley railroad.

Mr. Cochrane—It has not yet been signed, but the terms have been practically agreed to. They differ slightly from the terms arranged with the previous government. The province is to guarantee bonds to the extent of \$25,000 a mile, and the company is to be allowed to issue bonds in addition with a guarantee to the amount of \$10,000 a mile. There will be a subsidy of \$6,400 a mile from the federal government and the government at Ottawa will guarantee bonds for bridges to the extent of \$1,000,000. In addition there will be authority to issue additional bonds for betterments.

Mr. Carvell—Will the contract cover a line to Grand Falls?

Mr. Cochrane—It has not been arranged to Grand Falls as yet, but to Andover.

Mr. Pugsley—Is it arranged from Andover to St. John?

Mr. Cochrane—Well, I cannot say to St. John, for we do not know where we may make a railway connection for St. John, but it will be in the vicinity.

### NEW VARIETIES OF FRUIT: SOME BETTER THAN OLD

To the fruit-growers who met in conference in Ottawa recently Mr. W. T. Macoun, Dominion Horticulturist, gave a helpful paper on "New Varieties of Fruit." Mr. Macoun said in part:

"While the fruit-growers, fruit-buyer, fruit-shipper and nurseryman all agree that too many varieties of fruits are being grown in Canada, they also agree that all the varieties which are grown have, each of them, some decided faults. It will also be admitted, we think, that the fruit-growers in some parts of Canada have not as good a choice of varieties as those of the more favored districts, where a larger proportion of the good varieties offered for sale do well. These facts being known, the desirability of having new fruits which will have a larger proportion of good characteristics than those at present on the market must be apparent to all. Furthermore, those who live in the parts of Canada where climatic conditions enable them to grow fruits to better advantage than others must see the desirability of obtaining varieties which will be suited to the severer climatic conditions.

"The fact that our best varieties of apples, such as, for instance, the Northern Spy, Esopus Spitzenburg, Tompkins King, Grimes, Baldwin, Greening, Johnathan, and Newton Pippin, were nearly all originated over one hundred years ago, and some of them considerably over one hundred years ago, is no proof that newer and better varieties cannot be obtained.
