

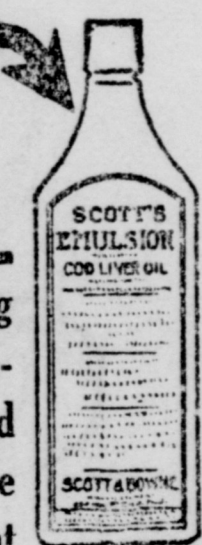
What Shall I Give?
