

N. B. POTATO GROWERS HAVE MUCH AT STAKE

F. B. Carvell, M. P., Takes the Matter of Proposed American Embargo up With Ottawa Authorities Who Will Be at Washington Conference

(Special to The Telegraph) Woodstock, N. B., Dec. 8.—A matter of great importance to the farmers of this district will come up at a conference in Washington, Dec. 18.—It has to do with the proposed embargo on the importation of New Brunswick potatoes into the United States.

F. B. Carvell, M. P., took the matter up with the department of agriculture at Ottawa some time ago has been assured that the department will watch the case closely. Mr. Carvell has advised strongly that a good defense be put up in order to protect the New Brunswick farmers.

It has been learned that on the representation of Aroostook county interests, an expert from the Maine State College, with a man named Martin, went through this district late last fall looking for a disease of some nature that would put potatoes under the embargo that applied to foreign countries. It is said that they found the "powdery scab" which is doubted very much.

No doubt every effort will be made by the Maine interests, especially, to bring the New Brunswick potatoes into disrepute, and recognizing this fact, Mr. Carvell is urging the department to prompt action.
