September 29th, 1894

Mr. Flemmington left for Sackville on Monday morning. During his stay here Mr. Flemmington has endeared himself to the members of the Methodist congregation, and made friends with all who came within the circle of his acquaintance.

Robert Kirk, Bedell Settlement, met with an accident on Monday. He was hauling potatoes from his field, and a sudden jerk of the sledge caused the barrel on which he was seated, throwing him off and between the horses and the sledge. He was dragged some distance and considerably cut about the face and bruised. Dr. Colter was called.

Alder Boyer, of Woodstock, and Frank Cullinan of St. Stephen, left on Monday morning intending to reach St. John the same night, on their bicycles. They reached Fredericton in season for an early dinner, stayed there some time and then resumed their journey to St. John. They were making good time and would have reached St. John that night, but that Mr. Boyer's wheel became badly damaged, so that they

had to lay by till morning for repairs.

Some confusion was caused in the churches, Sunday evening, by the ringing of the fire bell. The fire proved to be in the house, a short distance out the Houlton road, owned by Mayor Hanson. The house and barn, with the contents of the latter, 20 tons of hay, 2 sleighs, sled, etc., were burned. Loss about \$900, insured for \$300 on house, \$100 on barn. DOMINION ELECTION IN SPRING FOLLOWING A SHORT SESSION?

An Ottawa despatch says that Hon. W. J. Hanna and Hon. I. B. Lucks, Ontario ministers, had a chat with Sir Robert Borden and other members of the cabinet this week and it is learned that the political situation was the burden of the conversation. The present tentative arrangement of the government is to hold a short session of parliament this winter and go to the country next spring. It is well understood that the government will not wait until the conclusion of the war before going to the country. On Ontario the government will rely for its main support.

It is reported that large numbers of horses are being bought in the United States for the British army. A recent issue of an American horse paper states that an Illinois firm of importers and breeders have received a contract from the French Government to supply 15,000 horses at once the price ranging from \$175 to \$200. The same paper made an estimate that altogether it is expected that upwards of 100,000 horses will be contracted for in the United States for foreign governments to be used in the present war.
