

Death of Mrs. Norman Perry of West Glassville, N. B.

Early on Wednesday morning, the 22nd inst., at the home of her husband, Mrs. Norman Perry, of West Glassville, passed from the midst of her deeply grieved family. For the past few months she had been in failing health. Recently she consulted Dr. Connors of Bath, who advised her removal to Woodstock to undergo an operation. In order to comply with this advice Mrs. Perry placed herself under the care of Dr. Prescott. Before proceeding Dr. Prescott had a consultation with an eminent specialist and decided that it would be unwise for his patient to undergo the operation. Thereupon Mrs. Perry was brought back to her home, and for the few remaining days during which she suffered greatly, she was nursed with unremitting care by her sister, Miss Susan Reeder, who is in training as a nurse also by Mrs. Alexander Lyon. Their task was lightened by the assistance of other willing helpers. It is only fair to say that during Mrs. Perry's sojourn in Dr. Prescott's hospital nurse Wiley was most assiduous in her attentions and did all she could to alleviate the sufferings of the patient.

Always of a lovable and self-denying nature, Mrs. Perry forbore complaint, and was greatly sustained by an unwavering confidence in her Saviour.

The funeral procession was very large, testifying to the universal esteem in which the deceased lady was held. After appropriate services conducted by the Rev. James Colhoun (pastor of Glassville Presbyterian church), at the house, in the church, and at the graveyard, interment took place on Thursday afternoon, 23rd July, in the cemetery adjoining the Goudville United Baptist church.

Passing away at the comparatively early age of forty-four years, Mrs. Perry leaves many relatives to mourn her loss—those of the family circle being: Mr. Norman Perry, husband; Clarence and George, sons; Alice and Gladys, daughters; her mother, Mrs. A. Caldwell; her brothers, Wesley and George Reeder; her sisters, Mrs. H. Crane (Bath) and the Misses Alice and Susan Reeder.

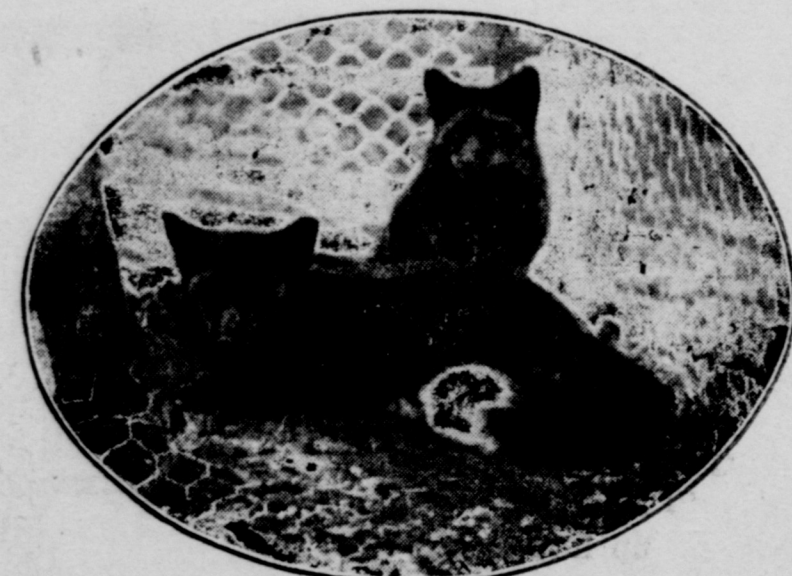
