



And there is still another advantage which makes this locality unique among the ports of Canada-it can be brought immediately in touch with U.S. railway lines. Vessels having passengers and mixed cargoes of freight for Canada and the United States could land their American passengers and freight at Eastport, Me., which now possesses railway connection, or at Robbinston, Me., where railway connect on could be easily provided, and their Canadian passengers and freight on the Canadian side of the St. Croix. This would be a great saving in time and expense, and it is time and expense that counts where a port is concerned.
