

## Seed Wheat

The Subscriber raised the Seed Wheat mentioned for sale below, at Kilmarnock in the parish of Northampton in 1915 and while it was growing the field was carefully gone over a number of times and kept clear of all foul seed and smut by hand picking. The grain was well ripened and harvested in good condition. It was threshed in a new machine and could not be infested by smut by the machine. It has also been put through a fanning mill and should be really cleaner and better than can usually be bought for seed.

125 Bushels Marquis Wheat. This is nearly three weeks earlier than other varieties. It was propagated in the Canadian West and a prize of One Thousand Dollars was won ahead of all competitors in America in New York a few years ago. The seed from which this was grown last year was obtained from one of the best seed houses in Canada.
