tween himself, E. W. Bassick and B. F. Yoakum, whereby they were to divide a commission of one million dollars for their trouble in negotiating their fuse contract with the Shell Committee at Ottawa. Yoakum was to get \$475,000; Bassick, \$275,000 and Cadwell was content with \$250,000.

When Mr. G. W. Kite, M.P., made his revelations in the House of Commons regarding the "rake-offs" on fuse contracts he read what Cadwell admitted today was a copy of the agreement entered into between the three men. Cadwell says that the money was to be divided "as and when the fuses were delivered." It was not to come out of the advance money, but from payments after deliveries.

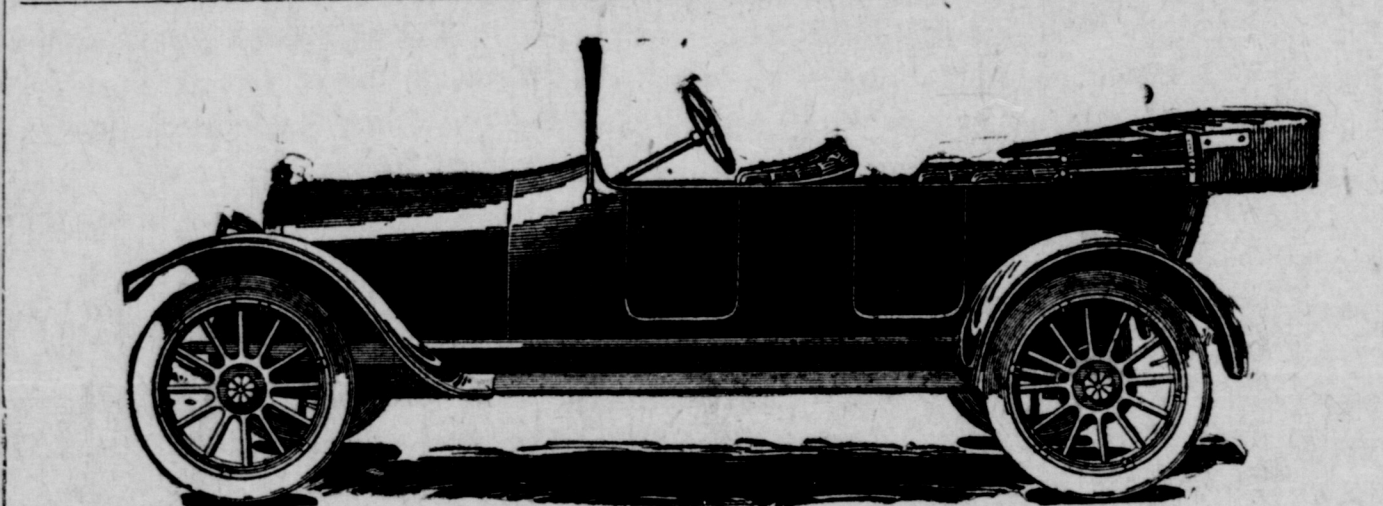
