

MORE GIFTS TO HALIFAX FROM MASSACHUSETTS

Ten Auto Trucks Accompanied by Experienced Chauffeurs. Cargo Valued at \$150,000.

Steaming closely behind the Calvin Austin and arriving not twenty four hours later, the steamer Northland entered the port of Halifax bearing a cargo valued at \$150,000, sent by the people of Massachusetts to the relief of the people of Halifax.

Mr. John F. O. Connell, a member of the Massachusetts-Halifax Relief Committee, came in charge of the party, with instructions to hand the cargo over to the Relief Committee here. There also came four nurses from the Massachusetts Eye and Ear Infirmary at Boston. When it became known that there were such a large number of patients who suffered with their eyes and ears, it was decided to send nurses here especially trained for that work.

A MUNIFICENT GIFT.

One of the most interesting portions of the Northumberland's cargo is the ten motor trucks, which have been presented as an absolute gift to the City of Halifax by the State of Massachusetts. These trucks are of the finest makes, and show an expenditure of over \$25,000. On the sides of each truck are signs reading, "Massachusetts to Halifax." There are included five Republics, three Whites and two Stewarts. Ten drums of gasoline also accompanied these trucks, as it was not known in Boston whether gasoline was plentiful here or not.

Each truck has a chauffeur, who will stay here until local men are trained and able to man the trucks. These chauffeurs are all Bostonians. When seen yesterday after the landing of the trucks, they proved to be an efficient looking business like crew.

The trucks were landed from the steamer, now at Whittman's wharf, yesterday afternoon, and about six o'clock proceeded to a point in front of the Halifax Hotel where they attracted a great deal of attention. Large numbers viewed the trucks and many made minute inspection of them. There was a parade held in the morning of the ten trucks through the principal streets, before they started their other work.



spired with an ambition to accomplish some noble purpose he made the Christian ministry his choice for a life's work. After teaching school for one year he entered Dalhousie University in 1906, planning to take there a four year's course in Arts, and then a course in Theology at the Presbyterian College, Halifax. During the summer of 1907 he preached in Brockway, York Co. In 1908 at Golden Grove, St. John Co., and in 1912 for a few Sabbaths at Glassville, Car. Co. But his hopes were disappointed, for after two very successful years of college work, his health failed and he was obliged to give up his course. For nine years he struggled manfully against his disease, two years of which he spent in the Sanitarium at Saranac, N. Y.

Mr. Hay was a young man of deep piety. His cheerful disposition and his consecration to the principles of Christ's teaching won for him a large circle of friends. He bore his illness with resignation and cheerfulness, and until the last few days of life kept himself familiar with the world's movements and took a keen interest in everything relating to human welfare.

Great sympathy is felt for the bereaved family in their loss of one whose qualities of mind and heart promised a splendid career of usefulness. While his loss is deeply felt by the whole community there remains the thought that his life, though brief, was not in vain, for his cheerful disposition, lofty ideals, patience in suffering and steadfast faith leave an influence that will bear good fruit in the lives of others.

Besides his parents he is survived by one brother Willie, who lives at home. The funeral took place on Tuesday afternoon. The services were conducted by Rev. R. J. Miller, assisted by Rev. Frank Baird. The body was laid to rest in the family lot at McKie's corner.
