form a government, and Premier Murray was urged to make preparations for another appeal to the people, advice which he wisely disregarded.

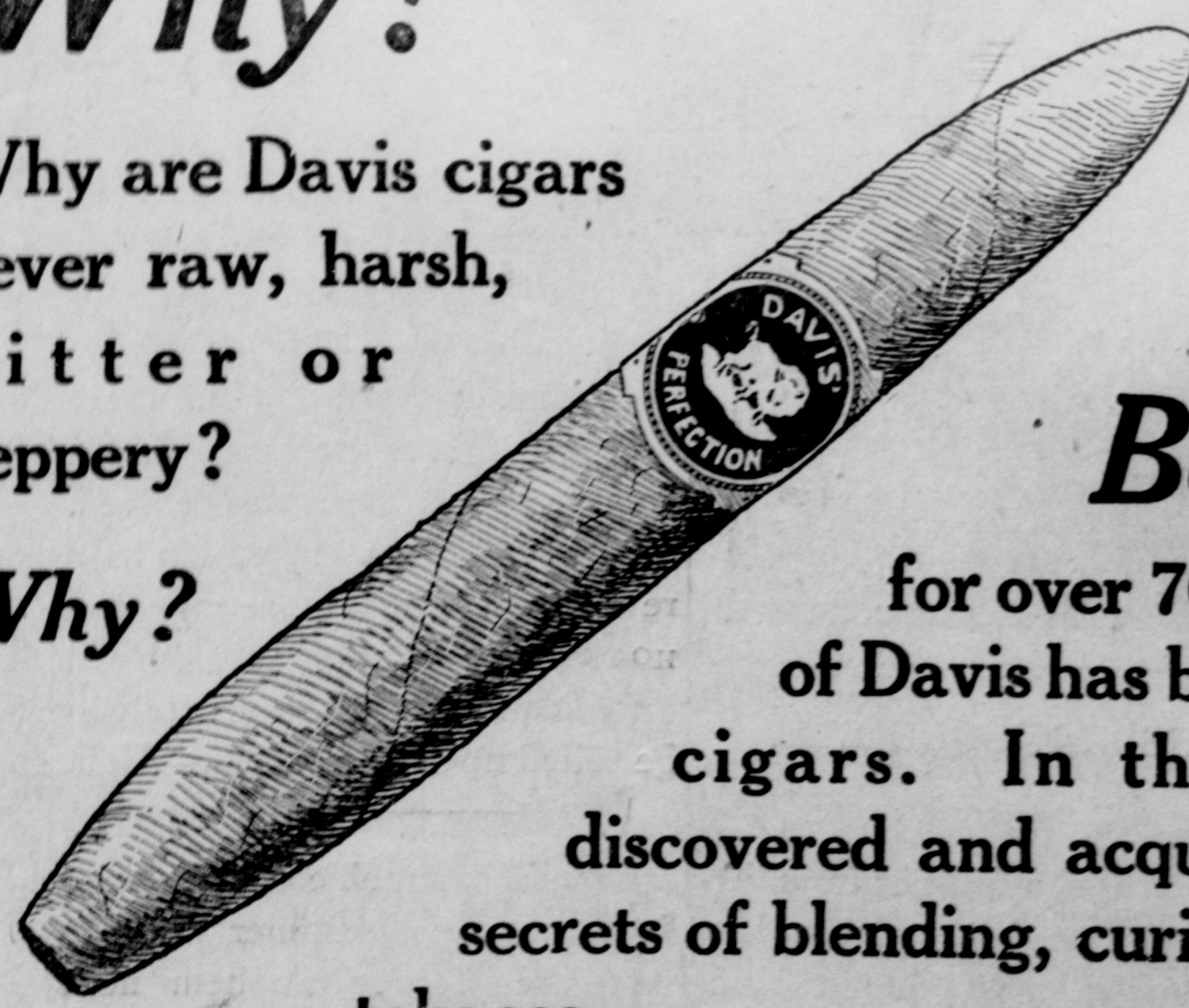
