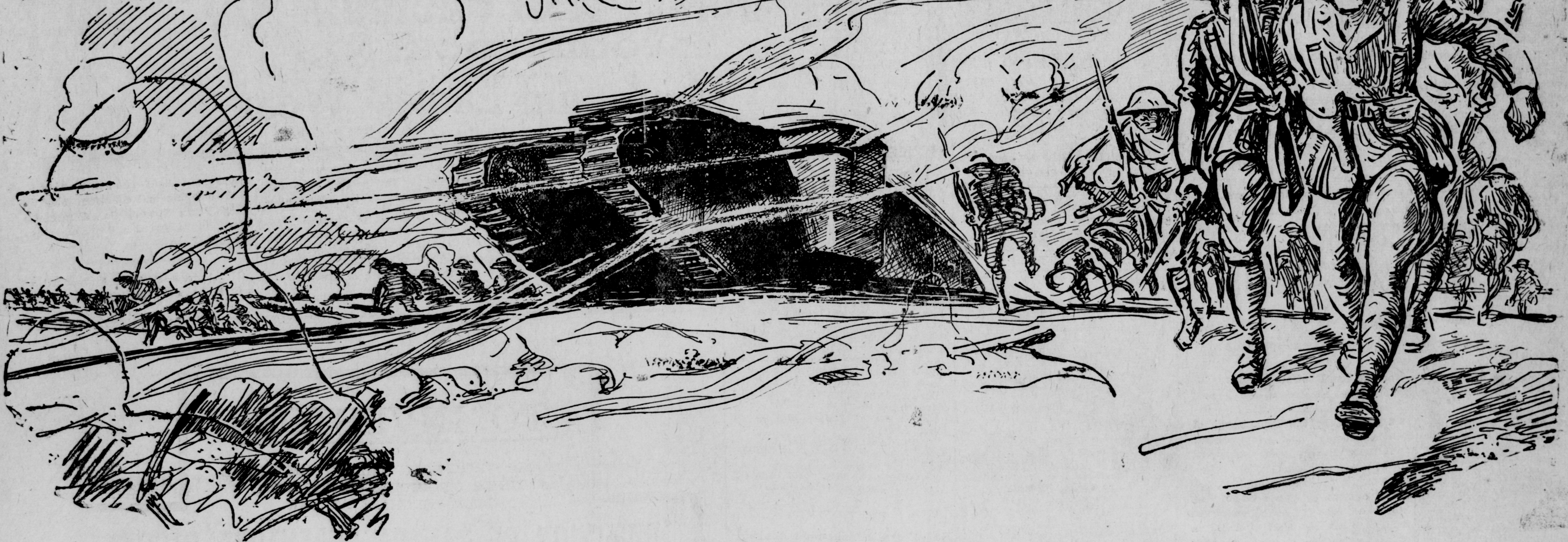

The Canadian Army in Action and the Advance of the Tanks



"At 6.24 a m. September 15, We All Went Over the Top"

Wednesday, March 21st, witnesses the first presentation in this Town of the Official War Film of the Canadian Army, and the first Moving Picture ever taken of the now Famous Tanks, which were successfully introduced into modern warfare by the British and Canadians on September 15, 1916. These are the Pictures Canadian Made—These are the Pictures the World Awaited.

The authenticity of the Pictures is Guaranteed by the Canadian War Records Office, under Sir Max Aitken (Lord Beaverbrook). The film is exhibited by authority, and copies will be preserved in the Canadian National Archives. Lloyd George, Premier of Great Britain, attended their first private view in London.
