### Water By-Law

(Continued from Page Two.)

combined water rates of his respective tenant in addition to the general service of the building.

In apartment blocks and double tenement houses the owner will be responsible for the payment of at least the minimum rate of each tenant, or the reading of the meter if it exceeds the total of the consumers rates.

**PAYMENT OF WATER RATES.**

30. The water rates shall be payable semi-annually on the first day of May and the first day of November at the office of the Collector of Water Rates. Any person who shall pay this water rate within fifteen (15) days after the first day of May and November in each year shall be entitled to a rebate of 20 per cent. of the amount of such rates.

**SCHEDULE OF WATER RATES.**

The following rates will be charged per annum—and will be payable on May 1st and Nov. 1st of each year and subject to a discount of 20 per cent if paid within fifteen days of the due date.

"106a.
