For all other municipal or corporation purposes the rates will be fixed annually by resolution of Council.

INDUSTRIAL OR MANUFACTURING PURPOSES.

Water supplied for industrial and manufacturing purposes, public garages, laundries, water motors and steam engines, schools and armories, shall be supplied by meter only.

METER RATES.

For the first 70,000 gallons annually at the rate of 50c. per 1,000 gallons.

For the next 70,000 gallons annually at the rate of 25c. per 1,000 gallons.

In addition to the above rates the consumer shall pay meter rental when the meter is supplied by the Town.
