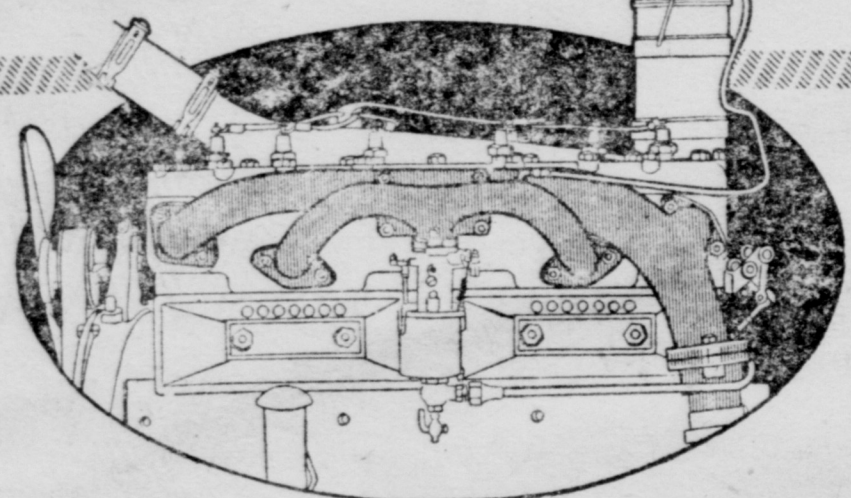

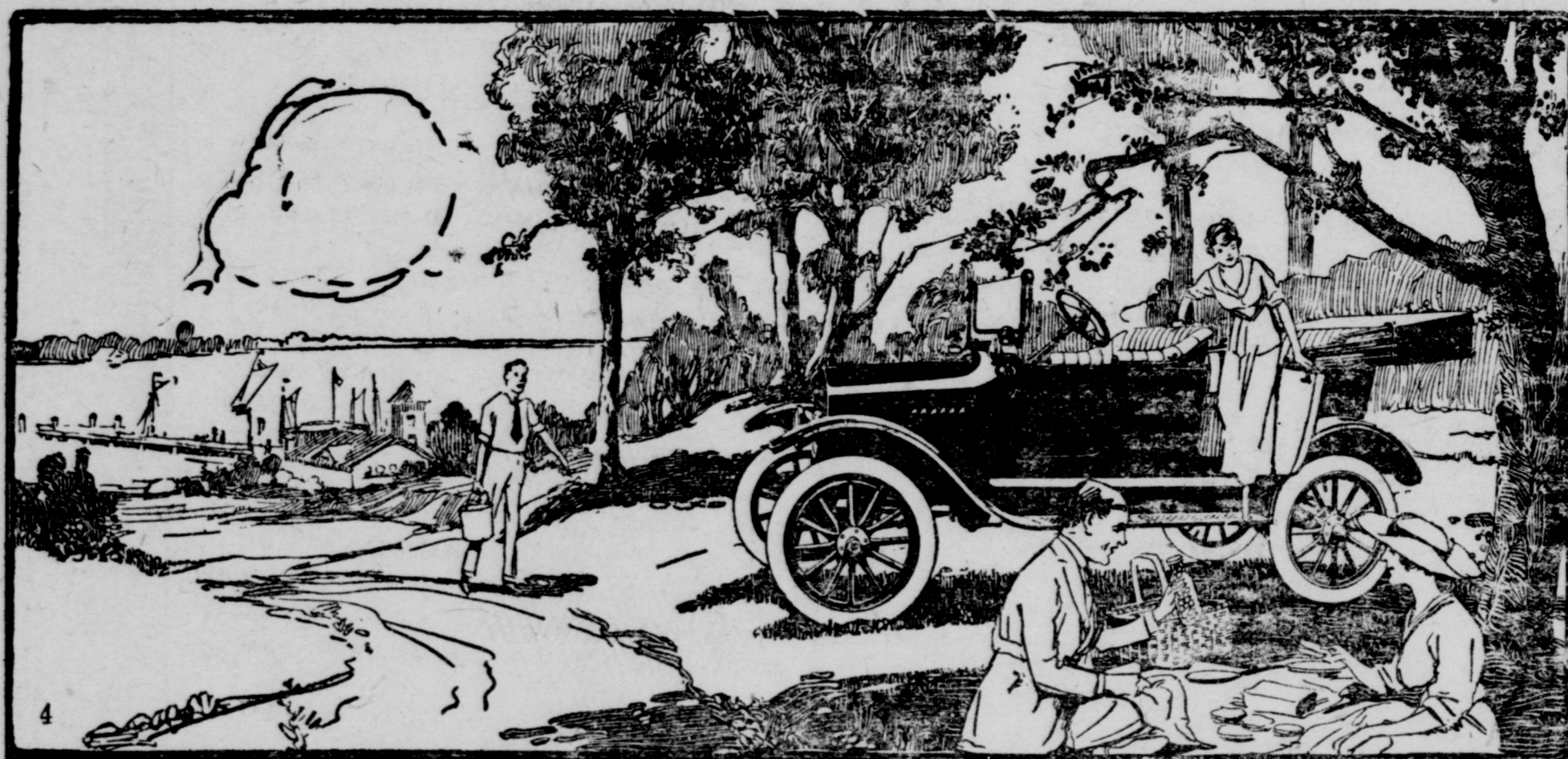

NOTICE is hereby given that at two o'clock p. m. on the eleventh day of May, 1918, at the Court House, Woodstock, N. B., the Dominion Government will offer for sale by public auction, its property near Woodstock, N. B., known as the Woodstock N. B. Rifle Range, which consists of all that certain lot or parcel of land and premises situated in the Parish of Woodstock, County of Carleton, Province of New Brunswick, which was acquired by His Majesty from Mr. John B. White and Jennie White, his wife, by deed dated the 19th day of October, 1904, and registered in the Office of the Registrar of Deeds for the said County of Carleton on the 28th day of October, 1904, containing by admeasurement 223.81 acres more or less, saving and excepting therefrom the right of way of the St. John and Quebec Railway Company across a portion of the same which right of way contains 7.72 acres more or less.

All information concerning the property may be obtained at the office of the General Officer Commanding, Military District No. 7, St. John, N. B., and the Town Clerk, Woodstock, N. B.

The sale of this property is subject to an upset price.

The highest bidder will, at the time of sale, deposit with the auctioneer an accepted cheque on a Canadian Chartered Bank for 10% of the amount of his bid, payable to the order of the Honourable the Minister of Militia and Defence, and within one month thereafter will pay the remaining 90% of the purchase price to the General Officer Commanding, Military District No. 7, by a cheque of a similar nature.

The Department reserves to itself the right to remove all parts of the present rifle range equipment, such as targets, etc., within three months from the date of sale of the property.
