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Licensing of Chauffeurs

Any person operating a motor vehicle as a chauffeur is required under an amendment passed at the last session of the Legislature to the Motor Vehicle Act to undergo an examination in order to obtain a certificate of competency.

The undersigned has been authorized by the Hon. P. J. Veniot, Minister of Public Works, to examine all applicants for a chauffeur's license and to issue certificate of competency which must be forwarded to the Department of Public Works. All parties desiring such examination must send in their applications to the undersigned immediately, addressed to Provincial Garage, Chipman Hill, St. John, N.B., so that they may be notified of the date and place of examination.

All chauffeurs now holding licenses obtained since January 1st, 1918, as well as all new applicants are required to undergo an examination.
