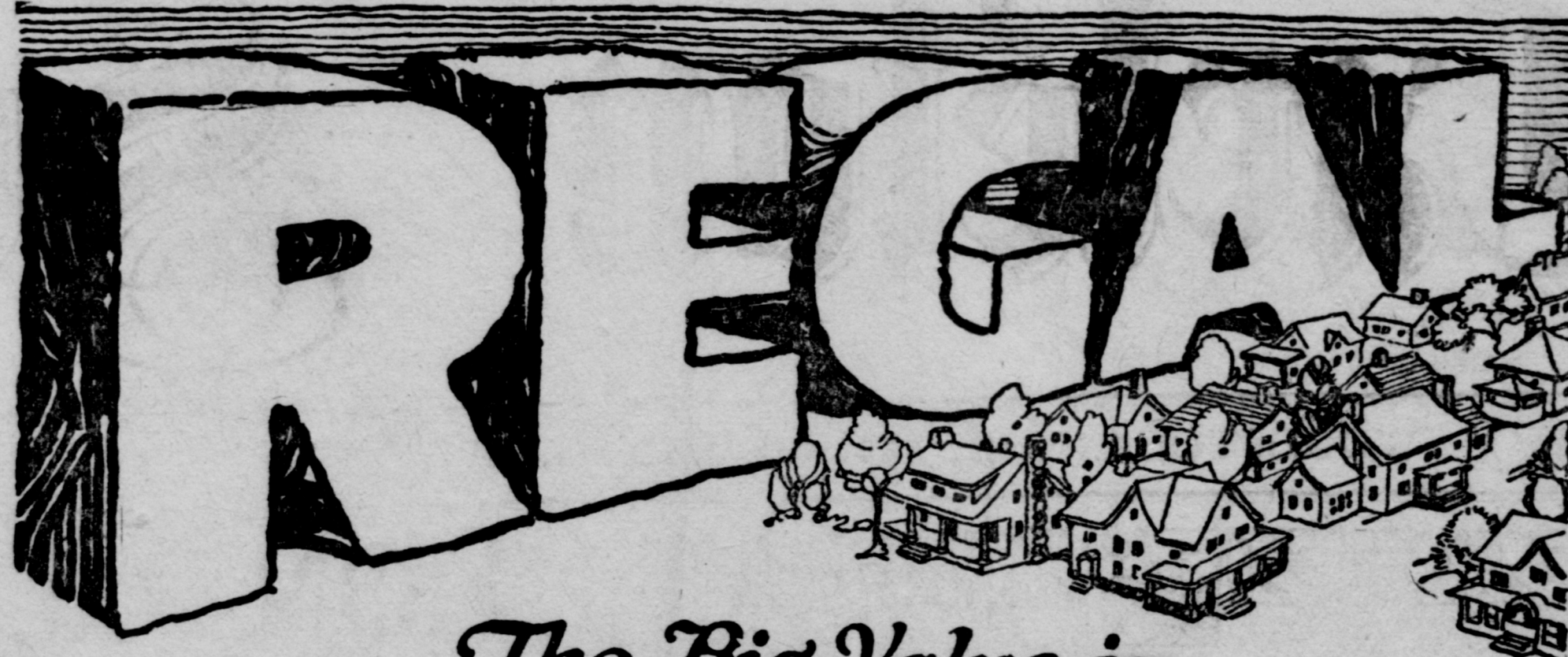

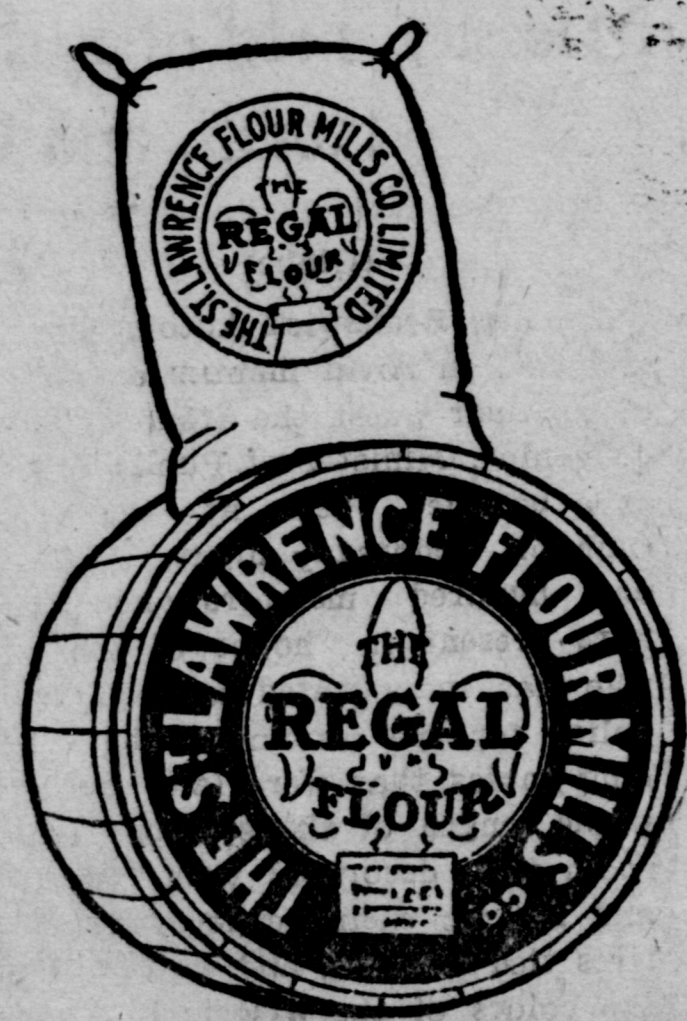

THE RETURNED MAN

Canadians who stayed home dur-
ing the war, be it from whatever
cause, can have little conception of
the feelings of the returned man who

comes back from four years spent
overseas battling for liberty, so
most any returned veteran will say.
As the majority of veterans them-
selves find it difficult to put into
words their experiences so that they
will convey a picture of reality to
the imagination of those who did

not go, this inability of civilians to
comprehend the changed feelings and
point of view of the veterans is ex-
cusable to a very large extent.

Aside from the physical experi-
ences and the change in mode of life
which are so difficult to convey to
the civilian mind, there are, how-
ever, which both civilian and veteran
ought to be able to find common
ground. It ought not to be difficult
for the stay at home civilian to un-
derstand how the soldier came home,
worn out physically and mentally,
tortured with the strife of battle,
and keyed up to fighting pitch for
four years, now desires to relax and
"let himself down" from the strain
of war.

The soldier comes home, expecting
to find a population united in effort
to do the most possible for him and
his, to heal the wounds of war, to
bring into practical effect that fel-
lowship and brotherhood of man
which was one of the lessons that
the war taught. Class organization
the grouping of men into hostile un-
its in his own country to struggle
with each other on a selfish plane,
cannot appeal to the returned man.
He feels, rather than reasons out in
such a class appeal, the threat to
the solidarity of the empire and the
safety of the flag for which he
fought. In Europe, he saw the ugly
things that hid beneath the cloak of
so-called "internationalism" and
"class interest," and he wants none
of them here. Politicians who are
endeavoring to raise the class issue
in free Canada are reckoning with-
out the returned man.
