COMMUTATION FARES HAVE ADVANCED

Increase on all Canadian Railway Lines Dates from May 1st.

Effective May 1st, commutation fares have advanced on all Canadian railways, and patrons of the Canadian National Railways have been advised that ten-trip tickets purchased prior to May 1st will not be honored, but should be handed in to the nearest ticket agent, so that refund of the unused portions may be obtained.

Patrons are also advised that this increase in commutation fares applies to ten trip, fifty trip and scholars' forty trip tickets. Ten trip tickets are limited to three months, instead of one year as heretofore, while regular fifty trip and scholars' forty trip tickets are limited to one month.

All who are holding these tickets purchased prior to May 1st should at once put them in line for redemption, either to the nearest Ticket Agent, or to the General Passenger Department, Moncton.
