Feb. 9th, 1895

A brother of the deceased reached here from St. John on Monday and another brother and sister from Boston, arrived on Tuesday, on the evening of which day they left with the remains for St. John.

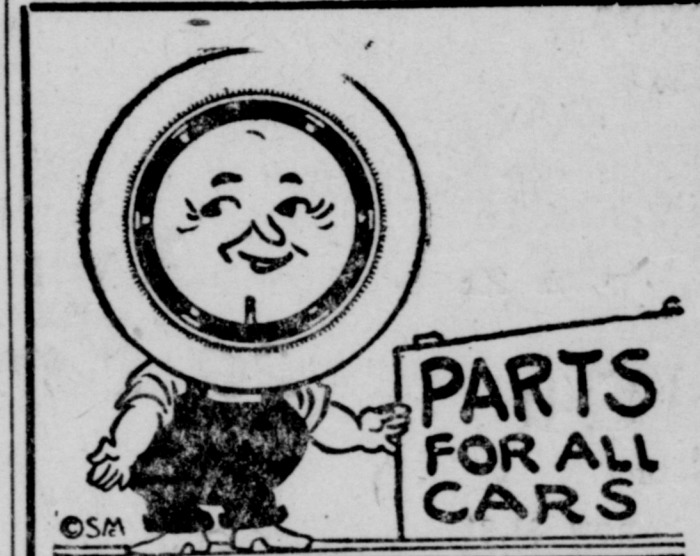

NOTICE OF LEGISLATION

Notice is hereby given that a Bill will be introduced at the next Session of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of New Brunswick, providing that all Acts relating to the Streets, Highways, and Side-Walks in the District known as the Upper Woodstock Road District, or the Upper District in the Parish of Woodstock, be repealed, and that the Upper Woodstock Road District or Upper District of the Parish of Woodstock, shall be brought under the provisions of the General Laws of the Province respecting Highways.
