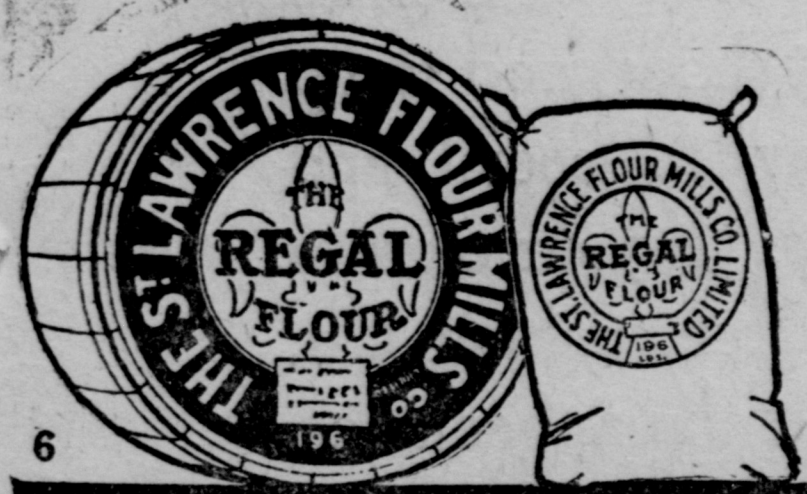

PREMIER FOSTER ISSUES A STRONG APPEAL TO THE ELECTORS OF N. B.

her of live stock in the province has greatly increased, and particular attention has been paid to the encouragement and development of the sheep industry.

CREDIT TO FARMERS

The present government provided the first system of extension of credit to farmers of the province on a sound business basis. The Department has sought in every possible way to give guidance and assistance to farmers, so that they may be enabled to surmount any of the many difficulties that are constantly presenting themselves.

GROUND LIMESTONE

Special reference is made by the Premier to the policy of developing a supply of ground limestone for the farmers. The ground limestone will be delivered, freight prepaid to farmers in the province for \$5.00 per ton, the cheapest lime being supplied anywhere in the Dominion and the best. Its general use will be an enormous saving to the farmers in their fertilizer bills, as it will put the soil in such condition that less fertilizer will give better results.

HIGH COST OF LIVING

No question causes such serious consideration as the increased cost of living, declares Mr. Foster. Unfortunately, no provincial legislation can control prices, but so far as increased production can relieve the needs and supply the necessities of our people the government will do all in its power. The cost of wheat flour from the west will probably advance with higher freight rates and the price of feed and oats and all western products will increase as well.

To make New Brunswick self-supporting; to assist our farmers in every way to raise enough wheat to supply all the people of this province with flour; to give such further assistance for the erection of flour mills as will make it possible for every farmer to easily convert his grain into flour and feed; to assist agricultural societies and communities to buy seed grain and to give such an impetus to production of all farm products as will increase our supplies and prevent the necessity of importing our food from outside our provincial borders will be the policy.

WORKMAN'S COMPENSATION BOARD

The Workmen's Compensation Board provided for by legislation passed in the early days of this government, says Mr Foster, has been of wonderful help and assistance not only to workmen generally, but to employers as well. Under its provisions every man employed in industries or on construction works in the province is not only protected but compensated for accidental injuries. The workman no longer has to meet his employer in a court of law in order to obtain compensation for injuries received in his service, and the mother or widow, deprived by accidental death of the support of her son or husband, is now promptly and generously compensated from the funds of the Compensation Board without having to go to law to seek redress. The preparation of this Workmen's Compensation Act and the amendments thereto have been but a small part of the work of the Department of Justice. In addition to carrying on the more important criminal cases of the country personally, the Attorney-General has bent his entire energies toward notable improvements in the statutes of the province. The amendments to the Successions Duties Act, County Court, and Probate Court Acts, and the far-reaching benefits to the public from the new Jury Act, which gives such additional protection to impartial tribunals in the courts, are among those worthy of mention.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT

New Brunswick was the most backward of all as regards attention to the physical welfare of her people, declares the Premier, and we have given her a health administration which (Continued on page six)
