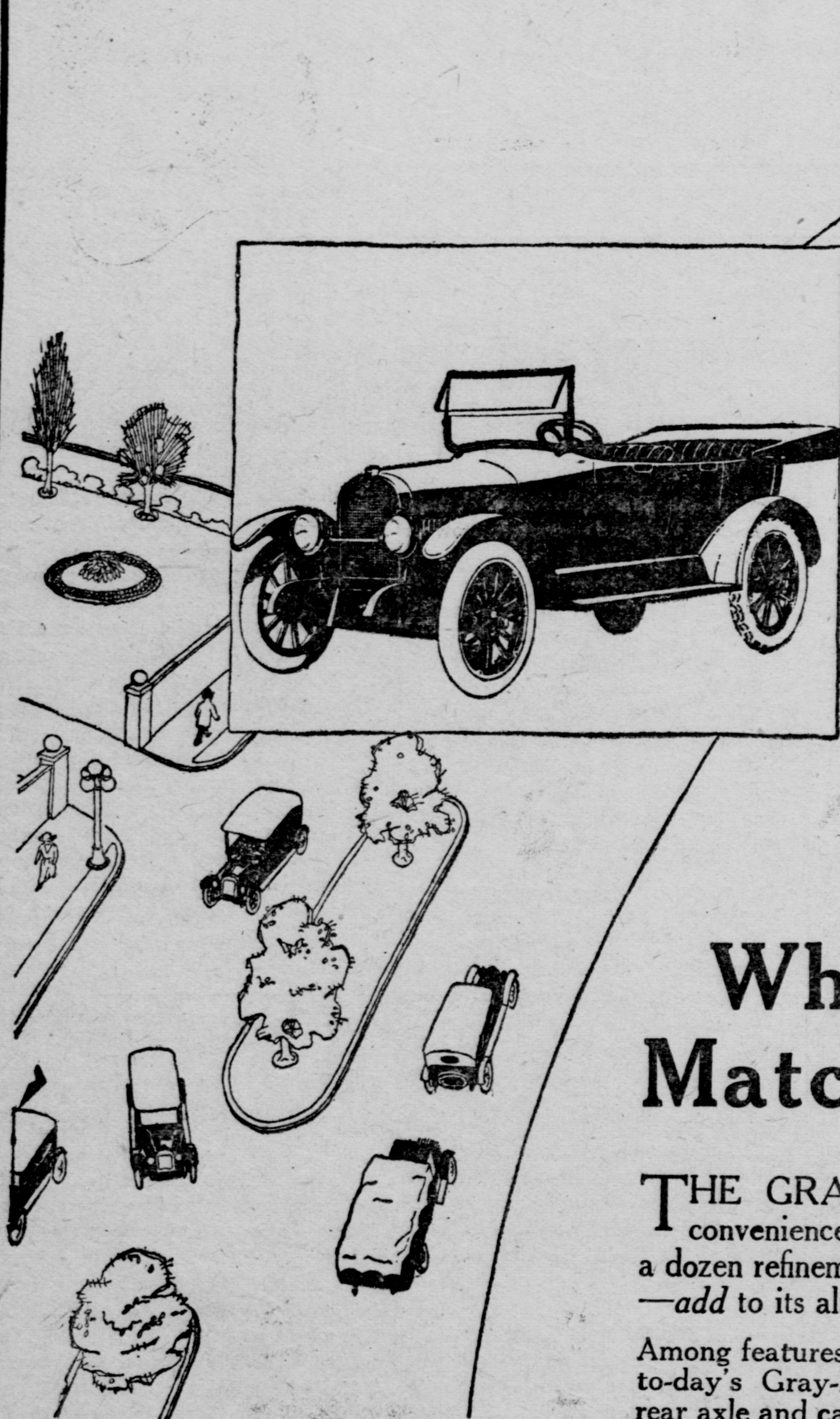

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TERRIFIC STORM HITS VICTORIA CO.

The Lightning Struck Several Places in Grand Falls, Folly, Brook and Elsewhere.

Grand Falls, Aug. 19—A terrific thunderstorm visited the town and vicinity recently. Lightning struck in several places in town, nineteen telephone lines were put out of commission and a few people received electric shocks. One bolt struck a chimney, in the shed at the home of the Misses Fraser, and though bricks and mortar were thrown about and other things blown out of place, no serious damage was done. Another bolt struck the chimney in the house owned by Paul Jovin and occupied by Mrs. J. W. West taking the chimney off the roof and splitting it for its whole length.

Lightning also struck a tree near Mr. Geo. McMillan's and the smokestack of uBrges mill.

No fire was set in any of the places. In Foley Brook, a house was struck and one of the occupants seriously injured.

HON. MR. KING REPLIES TO THE PREMIER.

Paisley, Ont., Aug. 12—Hon. W. L. Mackenzie King, chief speaker at a mass meeting of Bruce county Liberals in Paisley's beautiful Riverside Park this afternoon, devoted considerable time to replying to Premier Meighen's address at Stirling yesterday. He scored the premier's attitude toward the country at large as autocratic and lofty, picturing him as walking down the middle of a highway ignoring those on either side.

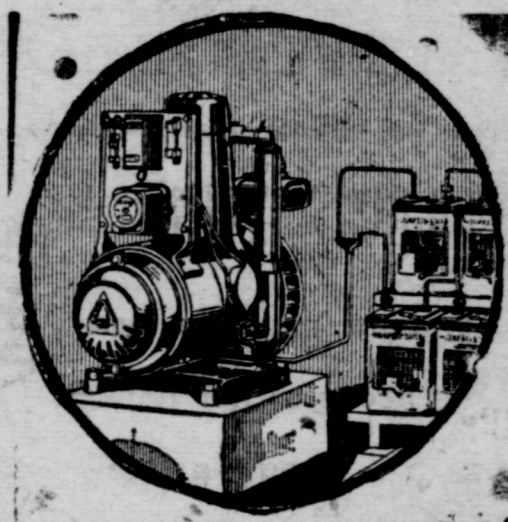
"I am reminded," he said, "of the Pharisee who kept to the middle of the road without allowing his garments to be touched by suffering humanity. There was another figure in that parable, and if Mr. Meighen wishes to play the role of the Pharisee I am content that the party I lead shall take the part of the Good Samaritan and do what it can to blind the wounds and better the conditions of humanity."

Besides the Liberal leader in the federal house, the list of speakers included Hartley Dewar, K. C., M. P. P., F. F. Pardee, M. P., West Lambton, and T. H. Marshall, M. P. P. for Lincoln. The chair was occupied by A. P. Mewhinney, M. P. P. for South Bruce. It was a hot day, but the 1,500 people who attended heard the speeches from very comfortable seats arranged under the shade of huge spreading elms. The town gave a warm welcome to the visitors.

The rally was arranged by the North and South Bruce Reform Associations and was more or less in the interests of R. E. Truax, M. P. for South Bruce, victor for his party in eleven previous contests, but now about to be matched for the first time against a U. F. O. candidate.

On the stage, or old stage road, trees, telegraph and telephone poles were torn down and garages at the homes of George Mulholland and James McCarthy were turned over and blown partly away. Altogether it was the worst electrical storm known here for years.

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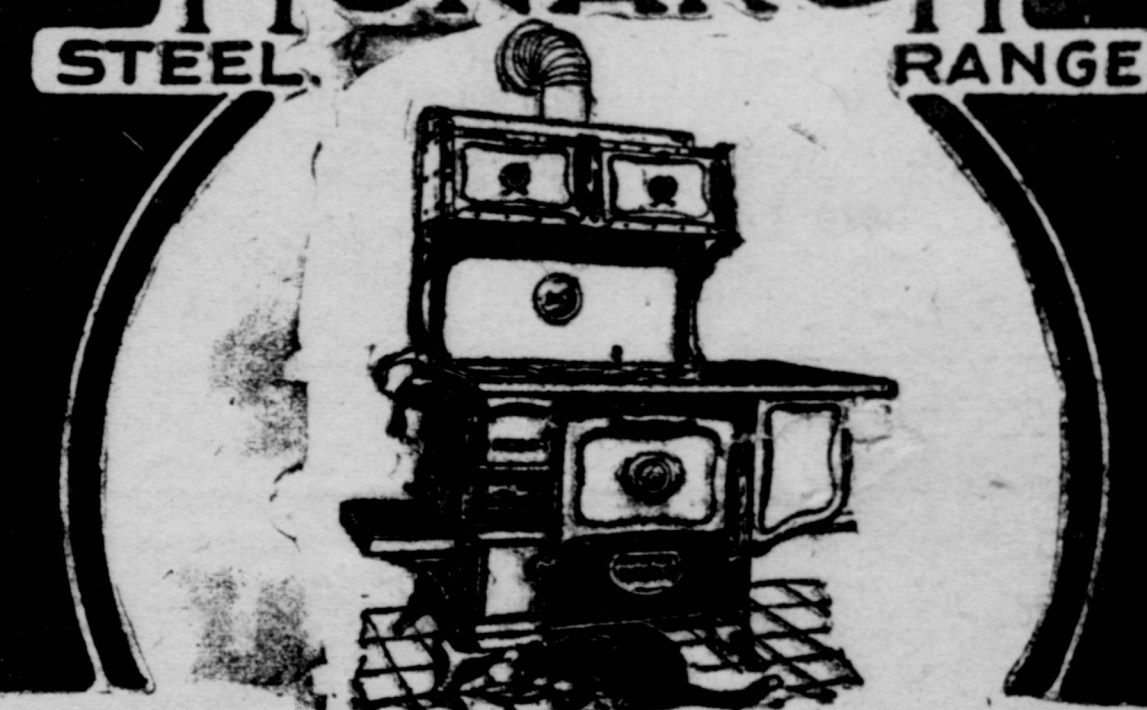

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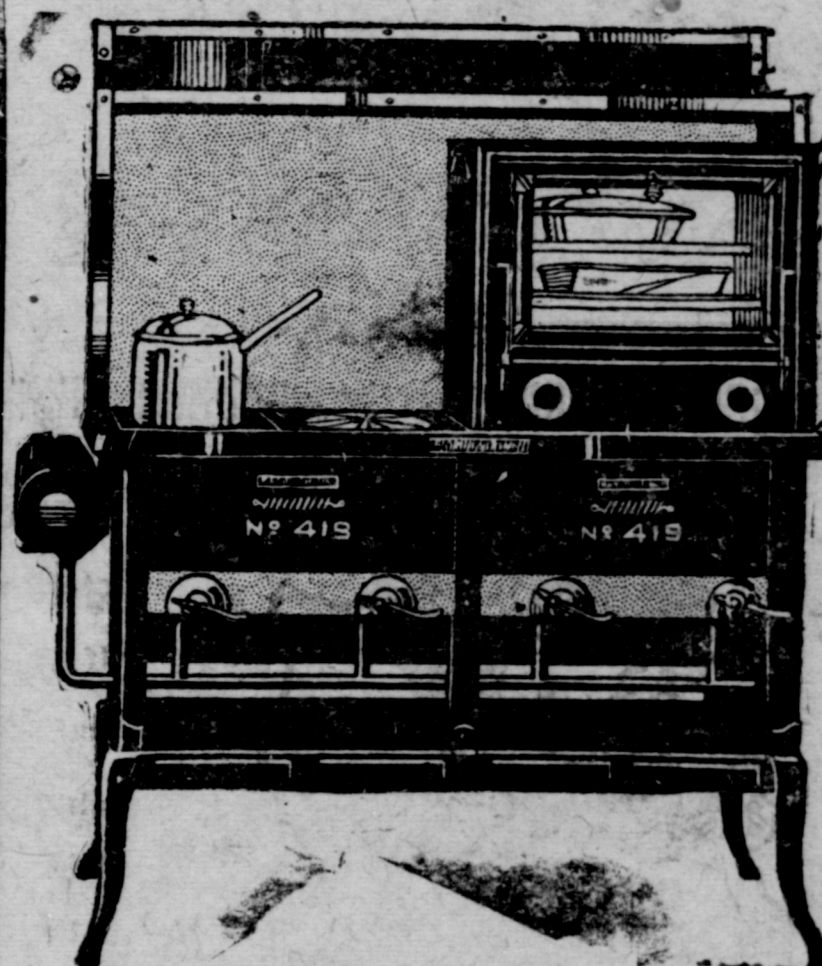
