CONFERENCE AT OTTAWA ON VALLEY ROAD

Matter Referred to Railway Board
--Premier Veniot and Others
Have an Interview With Premier King

Ottawa, Feb. 23--A private conference on the question of the federal government taking over the St. John Valley Railway was held this afternoon between the Prime Minister of Canada and the following delegation from New Brunswick, which was introduced by Hon. A. B. Copp, secretary of state; Premier P. J. Veniot, former premier W. E. Foster, Senator Onesiphore Turgeon and W. E. Scully, M. P.

After considerable discussion it was decided, according to a brief statement made later by Premier Veniot, that the whole matter would be referred to Sir Henry Thornton and the Canadian National Railway Board as a whole.

A Heavy Liability

Some interesting views on this subject are expressed in an editorial published this morning in the Ottawa Citizen, two paragraphs of which follow:

"The railway is a heavy liability on the province. Like too many other railway schemes in Canada it had a political inception. It furnished party funds for Conservative election campaigns in the province. The federal treasury contributed also, however, by granting double subsidies to the railway promoters. As the subsidies were granted during the term of office of the last Liberal government although they brought grist to the mill of the Conservative provincial machine, Premier Veniot may feel that the federal authorities have a certain responsibility for having helped to fasten this railway millstone around the neck of the province.

"It is not very clear how the government can take over the St. John Valley Railway; it cannot very well do so on behalf of the Canadian National system. At least, the country would be very much surprised to learn of the Canadian National Railway being so little removed from the influence of politics that still more bankrupt railway concerns could be added to it."

Premier Veniot said this afternoon that he had a conference this morning with Hon. J. H. King, minister of public works, and he came away persuaded that the federal government would take over the wharves on the St. John river.

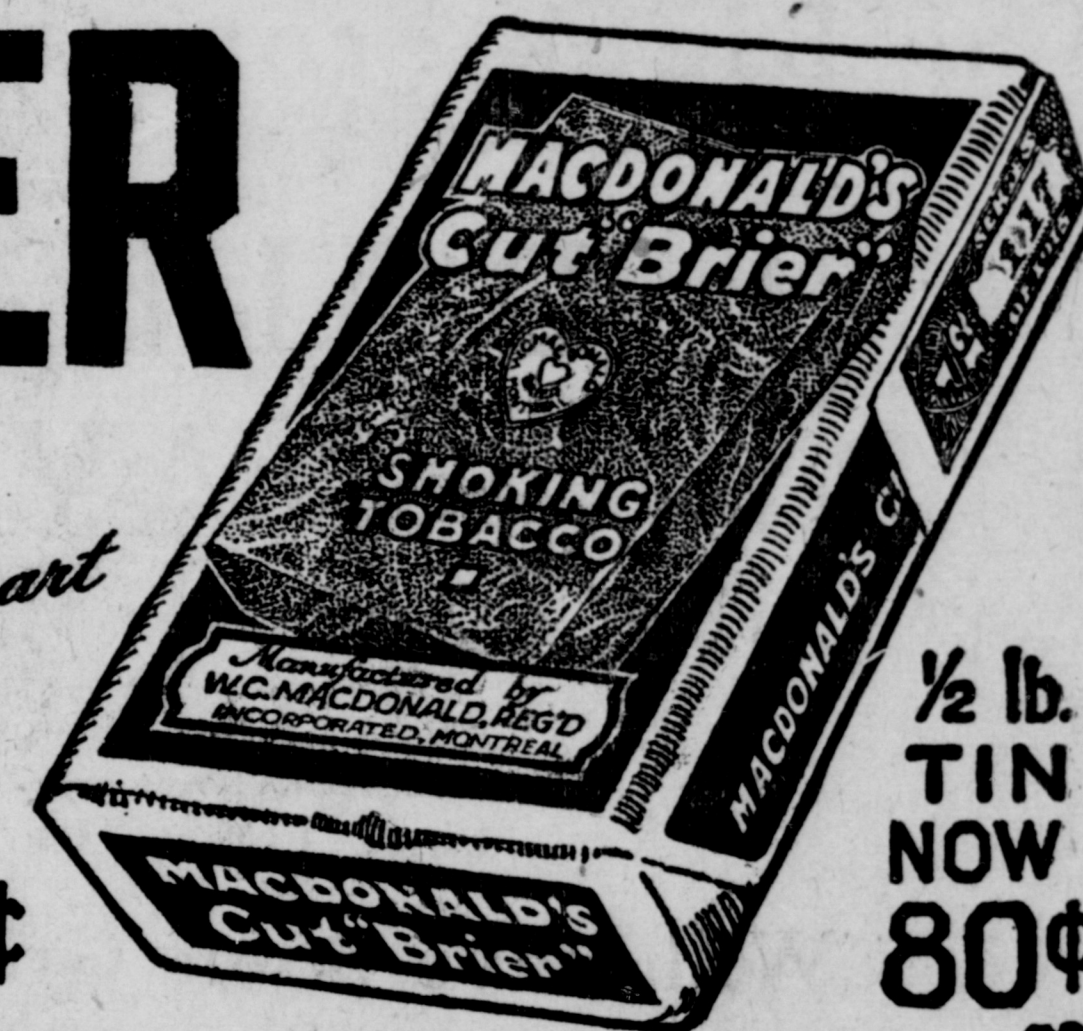
