The New Jewett Six

The new Jewett Six is on display at the local dealer's showroom. The three outstanding points in the construction of the new car, as advertised by the manufacturers tend to give maximum comfort, power and sturdiness. There are more than seventy improvements and refinements incorporated in the new Jewett, according to Harry Marsters, the Paige and Jewett dealer.

"A full fifty horsepower six-cylinder motor and unusual strength gained by more than average weight make of the Jewett a car in a class by itself," says Mr. Harry M. Jewett, president of the Paige-Detroit Motor Car Company, builders of the new line. "Extra power gives the Jewett stability as well as the ability to perform and demonstrate that it is in no sense a 'light six.'" Great structural strength makes of the Jewett an automobile that stays out of the repair shop.

"During 1923, the Jewett was the winner of hundreds of hill-climbs and acceleration contests against open competition. The contests were held in every section of the United States and many foreign countries.

"In New York State alone, Jewett has five straight wins to its credit at Albany, Syracuse, Oneida, Stockbridge and Jamestown. In the middle west we have the records at Keokuk, Iowa; Quincy, Illinois; Lansing, Michigan; and Duluth, Minnesota. In the west Jewett has won a record on many hills including Pickle Hill at San Francisco; Reno, Nevada; Salt Lake City; and Portland, Oregon.

Wins Speed Events

"At Chapultepec, Mexico, a Jewett stock car stripped, won the major speed tests, several of nearly one hundred miles.

Our dealer at Melbourne, Australia, holds all the cross-country records for that country. The Casper, Wyoming stock car race record fell before a Jewett. A Phoenix, Arizona cross-country record set by a Jewett still stands. These are some of the outstanding racing events won by a Jewett. The list of all the wins would fill several paragraphs."

The Jewett which to-day holds such an enviable record of performance in competition with practically all makes of motor cars built in the United States and many foreign countries was the foundation on which has been built the new Jewett.

Some of the more important improvements are: Larger brake drums (14 inch replacing 12); heavier wheels (larger spokes); pressure oiling for chassis; improved valve mechanism; new carburetor; new thumb type spark and throttle controls; new type instrument panel (better grouping of instruments); new and more efficient emergency brake; velour upholstery in standard closed models.

Natural development of the Jewett has led the manufacturer to add a larger oil pump with far greater capacity; oilvac gasoline feed, which is a vacuum system dependent on the oil supply giving insurance against the vacuum tank ever running out of gasoline no matter how long the hill or fast the speed (it is impossible to run a motor when out of oil as gasoline feed is dependent on engine oil creating vacuum); new camshaft and valve and tappet control; new fan with pressure oiler; new tail lamp; new re-inforced transmission brake drum; and a host of minor refinements bringing the total up to seventy-three.

Seats More Comfortable

Added comfort has been provided in all Jewett models by re-designing of the seats. Deeper upholstery has been added; in some models wider seats are being furnished; in most models, the tilt of the back and seat cushions has been changed to give greater comfort; and in all chassis the gear shift lever has been placed in a more natural and convenient position.

The external appearance of both the Standard and De Luxe Jewetts is slightly changed. The lamps of

all models have gone through several improvements and are of a different shape. A one-piece windshield doing away with the barrier to the vision in the centre of the conventional types, has been adopted on open models as well as a new style of corrugated rubber running-board mat, which prevents feet slipping and reduces wear.

Both lines of models are manned by the Jewett six-cylinder 50 horsepower motor. This is a development of the engine which established a reputation for economical operation during its past seven years of use in the hands of 110,000 owners and over two billion miles of travel.

The standard line of Jewetts is furnished in three models, a five-passenger touring car, five-passenger brougham with baked enamel finish and five passenger sedan. The first two are finished in black and the latter in dark blue. The touring car is upholstered in natural leather, the brougham in velour and the sedan in brown velour.

The De Luxe Jewetts continue to be distinctive models. The three models furnished in this line are: three-passenger roadster, five passenger touring car and five passenger sedan. All are finished in the same coach blue light color which attracts the eye of all beauty lovers. The roadster and touring car are upholstered in hand-crushed Spanish leather and the sedan in broadcloth.

Full Equipment

The De Luxe Models are fully equipped with a spare tire, mounted complete with drum cover on the left side of the sedan and touring car and the rear of the roadster; trunk rack and trunk (except on roadster); combination tail and stop light; two double bar spring bumpers, motorometer; drum sidelights on cowl; all nickel headlamps; nickel radiator; automatic windshield wiper; rear view mirror (except roadster); sun visor; Marshall type springs; and heater in the sedan.

"I am confident that the Paige-Detroit Motor Car Company," states its president, "is now giving the biggest dollar's worth in motor car on the market in the new Jewett Six. As we have predicted during the past year, the public has found that during 1924 its motor dollar goes farther than ever before."
