CANADIAN INDUSTRY IS URGED TO MAKE A NEW DEPARTURE

SHOULD TAKE PUBLIC INTO ITS CONFIDENCE, SPEAKER DECLARES

Toronto, Ont., Dec. 8.—Urging that Canadian industry as a matter of immediate national importance undertake a new public function which, for some, would be a complete reversal of past policy and for all, would involve a new educational technique, J. L. Stewart, speaking for the automotive industries of Canada told an executive group of these industries here last night that the function to which he referred could be described as "taking the public into its confidence."

The meeting was held following the sessions of the Automotive Transport Association which closed on Saturday. It marked the formal launching today of closer relationships between the automotive industries and the general public throughout the Dominion. Newspapers from coast to coast constitute the medium through which this development is to be accomplished. In his address, Mr. Stewart was presenting the results of a detailed survey of the subject which he has just completed.

Mr. Stewart first explained what he meant by industry taking the public into its confidence. It was not, he said, as simple as it might sound but a procedure which had not been carried out in the past in anything but the most modified form. It was not a question of issuing unexplained sheaves of statistics. It was something which except indirectly was likely to be completely divorced from sales. This was a problem of interpreting Canadian industry to Canadians in shirt-sleeve phrases. It was not so much a question of stating what industry was doing or how much it was doing but rather a case of explaining how it was doing it, why it was doing it and what effect all this had on the life of John Smith.

"In the past, industry has suffered because the public was not in its confidence," the speaker declared. "There was even the feeling in some quarters that industrial activity was to a degree mysterious and carried on behind closed doors. It is not going too far to say that this atti-

tude of mind was encouraged in an earlier era. But the time for that brand of secrecy is gone. It is definitely injurious. All it can achieve is to breed misunderstanding and

place an industry in the same relative position as the man who complains of lack of appreciation on the part of his best friend and most severe critic.

Mr. Stewart then went on to emphasize that it was not primarily from the viewpoint of industry itself that he urged these radical de-
