

Lieut.-Col. Wilfrid Bovey, O. B. E., LL. D., D. Litt., director of extra-mural affairs, McGill University, and chairman of the Legion's Education Division, in his report told the convention that efforts are being made to establish a standard elementary and secondary school course for the benefit of enlisted men in Canada. He said that "this is important when consideration is given to the fact that members of the forces are continually moving from one province to another."

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London, June 10—Major-General L. W. Amps, Director of the Auxiliary Military Pioneers' Service, Royal Engineers, called recently for recruits of all ages for a new kind of army to fight for good against evil. General Amps spoke with an admiral just returned from convoy duty and a major from the British Expeditionary Force, to an enthusiastic audience of thirteen hundred people in Battersea Townhall, supporting the Mayors' Moral Re-Armament campaign to strengthen the moral fibre of the British people.
