Parliament will meet on Thursday, January 26th.

A Washington dispatch says that United States Senator Hill has been tendered the portfolio of secretary of state by President-elect Cleveland in person.

The Canadian government has invited the Imperial Government to send a commission to Canada to inquire into the sanitary conditions of Canadian cattle at Canada's expense.

A Jewish inn keeper in the outskirts of Vienna Austria, his wife and four young children, have been murdered by nine tramps, whom the inn keeper refused to supply with food.

Premier deBoucherville of Quebec, has resigned, and his resignation has been accepted.

Representatives of the Montreal, Toronto and London boards of trade interviewed Sir John Thompson and Hon. Messrs. Foster and Angers urging the government to introduce an insolvency bill into parliament at the next session.

The British Authorities have again refused to release Mrs. Maybrick, on the plea of illness, which has been put forward by her friends.

The final official statistics of the cholera epidemic in Russia have just been issued.

Mr. Brosius, representative of Pennsylvania has introduced in Congress for reference, a bill to provide for the improvement of the federal quarantine service.
