## M. ALBINO'S Notes.

Owing to the large and increasing attendance at the Ladies' College it has been found necessary to provide a larger dining hall. For this purpose the old gymnasium, on the north side of the tennis court, will be moved to a position in the angle formed by the ell and the main building on the west side and connection made with the main college. The cellar has already been dug and the work of moving the building will begin at an early date. The contract for digging the cellar has been let to Daniel McCarthy, the masonry to Messrs. Stultz and the moving to Burton Estabrooks. When completed the new hall will provide accommodation for 150 students. The present dining hall accommodates 108 and is now taxed to its full capacity and the attendance is usually greater during the second term. The present dining hall will probably be converted into a reading room.

It has also been found necessary to enlarge the dormitories. When the main college was built the mansard was left unfinished. Some years ago it was found necessary to finish some of the rooms and now it has been found necessary to finish eight to meet the requirements. Tenders were made by Messrs. Rhodes Curry & Co., Amherst, R. C. Donald, Moncton, Elgin Manufacturing Co., Hiram Copp and J. W. Doull, Sackville. The contract was awarded to Doull, the work to be completed by December 31st.

A new instrument for teaching the pipe organ will shortly be purchased for the Conservatory of Music.

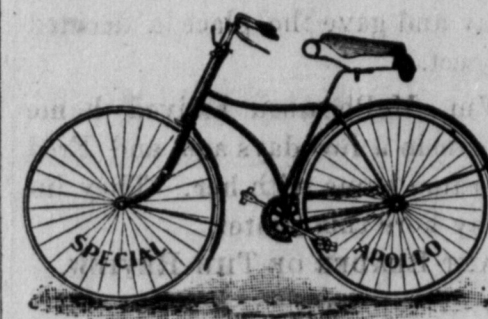
