Telegraphing Without Connecting Wires. Interesting experiments have recently been made under Mr. W. H. Preece, with a view to electric communication between distant points without wire con-

nection, namely, through air, water, or earth. Mr. Preece proposed to conduct experiments in three different methods. First, by running a wire along the shore on light poles for a distance of about a mile, and a second wire from stem to stern of the ship, the two acting upon each other inductively through the intervening space; secondly, by suspending a short line over the side of the ship, so that it might dip into the sea in the direction of the end of the shore line; to work by conduction through the sea; and, thirdly, by running out a light cable from the shore to the ship, termin-ating in a coil at the bottom of the sea, not subject to the caprices of the English parties, should alone be accentable to the near the ship, but not attached to it, while another coil is placed on board.
