PINE CITY, Minn., Sept. 5.—The complete corrected list of dead at Sandstone numbers 78. About everything in the town was burned.

NEW YORK, Sept. 5.—The war waging between organized carpenters and subcontractors or lumpers bids fair to be long and bitter. The present fight is not a question of wages or hours, but to do away with the present system of lumping or sub-letting of contract jobs. Nearly 1,000 men have been called out already, quitting work on over 150 buildings. It is stated that within 48 hours the number will be increased to 2,500, tying up work on over 250 jobs.
