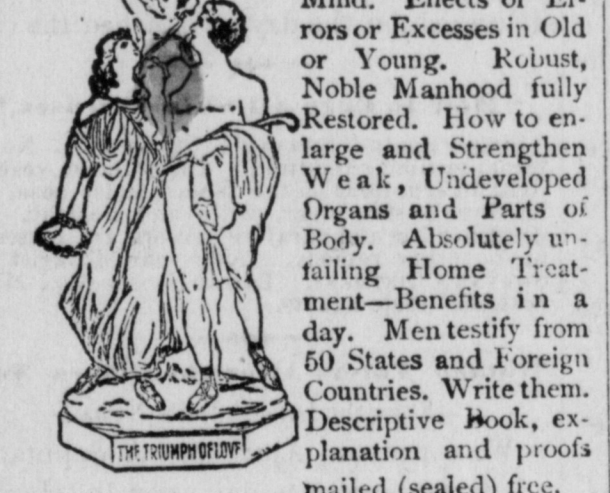
MAY 10th.—It is with deep regret we chronicle the death of Agnes Beers, which took place at the home of her parents on the morning of the 7th May.

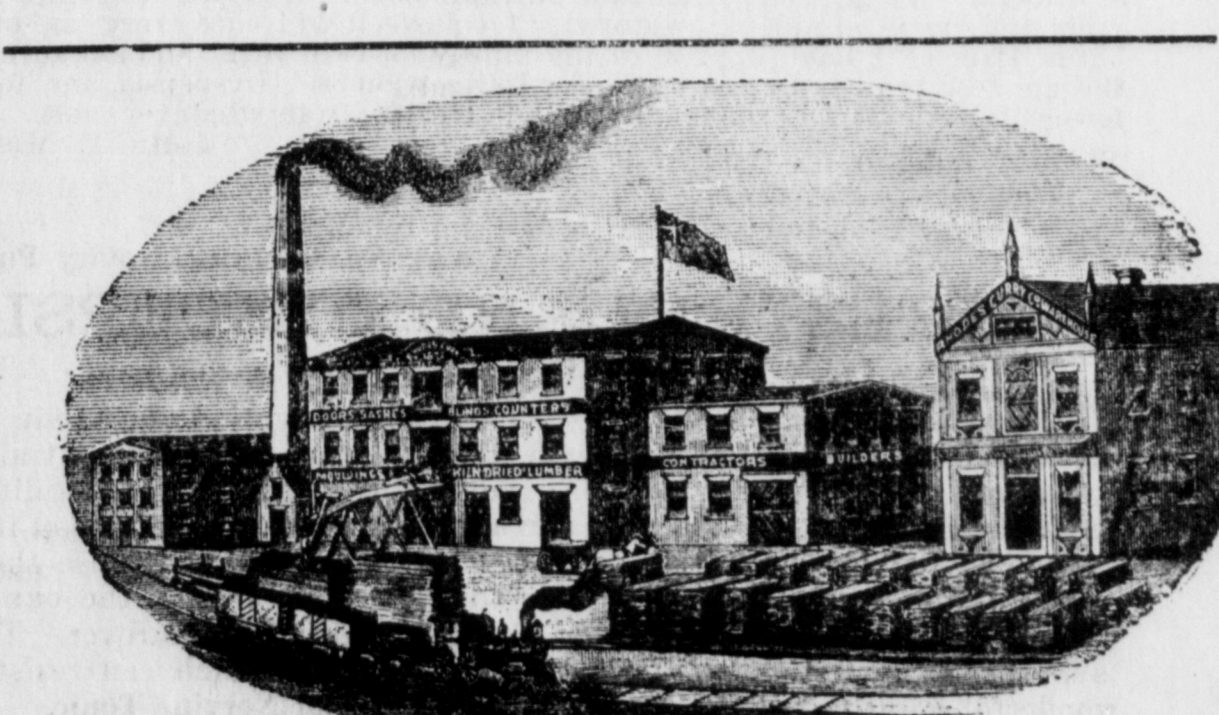
