A Potato Fertilizer.

The April Bulletin of the New Hampshire agricultural station gives the result of several experiments with a potato fertilizer which is considered the best that has yet been devised for that section of the country. The formula of the fertilizer is as follows:

Dissolved bone black, 500 pounds	\$6.25
Muriate of potash, 150 pounds	3.15
Sulphate of ammonia, 50 "	2.00
	\$11.40

These chemicals are all dry and harmless substances, as easily mixed as cornmeal, shorts and middlings. The amounts are for one acre where no manure is used, and in every case on planted crops use either 300 or 350 pounds of the mixture broadcast, putting only from 150 to 200 in the hill or drill, and do not let it come in contact with the seed. On ten farms one dollar invested in this fertilizer gave increased crops valued at \$2.07 each; on twenty farms the increase was valued at \$4.20 each, and on ten others, at \$6.05 each. No barnyard manure was used and the crops were little affected by rot.

A Terrible Earthquake.

CARACAS, May 11.—A terrible earthquake occurred in Venezuela April 28. The reports which have been received here from the districts affected tell of terrible loss of life and destruction of villages and towns. The cities of Merida, Lagunillas, Chiguara and San Juan, situated in the north of the republic in the region of the Andes, are reported as having been totally destroyed by a fierce shock at 11 o'clock on the night of the 28th. Many villages are said to be wrecked, but details are not yet to be had.

The convulsion extended to parts of the adjacent republic of Colombia. The full details of the catastrophe will be learned slowly, but it is probable that 11,000 people have perished, and it is certain that the greatest suffering prevails in the places visited by the earthquake.

Timely Hints.

A good dose of fertilizer will not hurt the oats if it is a kind containing a large per cent. of potash and phosphoric acid, but nitrogen is not generally needed. It is a mistake to suppose that they do not need any more plant food than is found in the soil.

It is better to be behind your neighbors in turning your stock to pasture in the spring if you would be ahead of them in having abundant pasturage in August when it will be most needed. Give the grass a good start, for the cattle will catch up with it.

If you cannot afford glass sash for a hot bed, procure some plant cloth. It costs but a third as much as glass, and is durable and answers the same purpose. Most seedsmen keep it. It can be tacked on frames or drawn over the bed and tacked at the ends. It is also used largely for making plant protectors and for building temporary chrysanthemum houses in the fall.

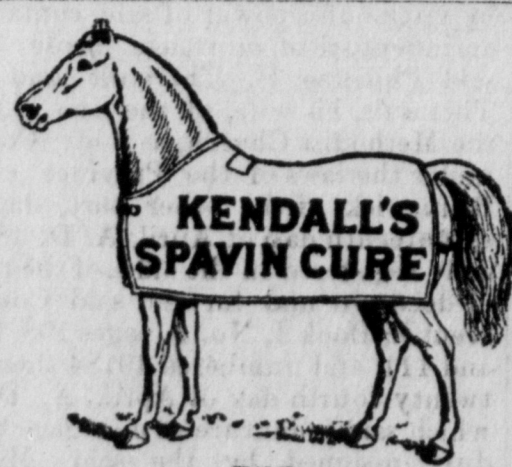
