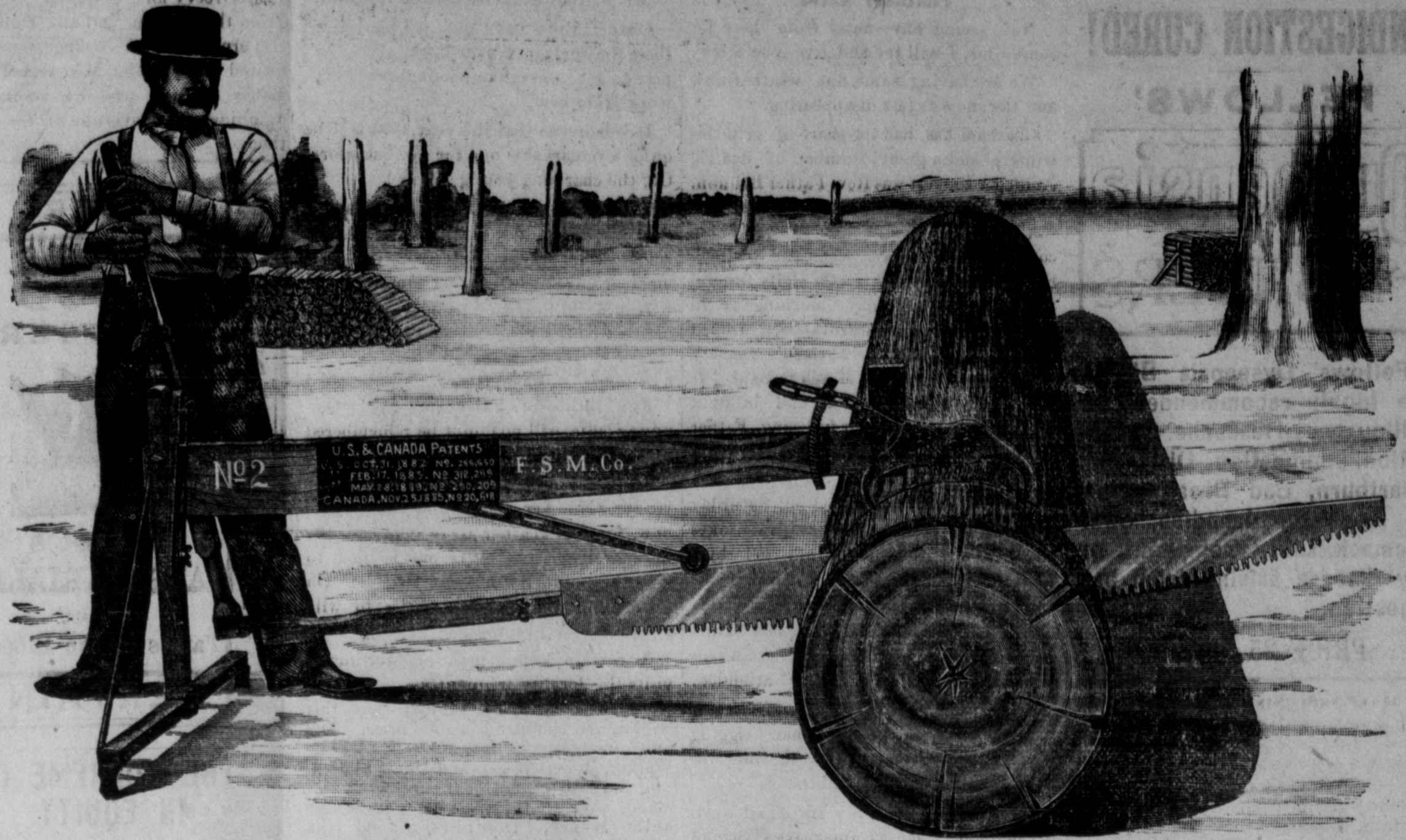

TO STEAM A FISH.—Having it properly scaled, dressed and well washed, secure the tail of the fish in its mouth; lay it on a plate and pour over it a cupful of vinegar, into which you have stirred a teaspoonful of salt; sprinkle with pepper and let it stand in the ice box an hour; pour off the vinegar; put it in a steamer over boiling water and steam until the fish is nearly done; about twenty minutes for a medium sized fish. Drain well and serve with the sauce known as Maitre d'Hotel.
