So much fruit has been raised in California this season that the local markets have been glutted, and in San Francisco tons of melons, pears and plums have been thrown into the sea. One day recently cantelopes were selling in San Francisco for ten cents a crate, and watermelons could not be sold even at two to five cents each. That same afternoon 600 crates of cantelopes, 200 crates of watermelons, and a great amount of plums and pears were dumped into the bay.

In consequence of the record-breaking in Britain by the locomotive of the London and Northwestern railway, one of which covered 540 miles in 512 minutes, succulation is being indulged in as to the possibility of an American engine attaining greater speed. The best schedule time made in America is that of the Empire State express, which covers the distance between New York and Buffalo via Albany (440 miles) in 520 minutes. To race over the rais at the same speed as its English rival the American train would be obliged to accomplish its journey in 417 minutes. The English locomotive has therefore outfooted the swiftest American rear of the rails by a gain of nearly one and three quarter hours. The English train averaged a mile in .94 minutes ; the American train, a mile in 1.48 minutes.
