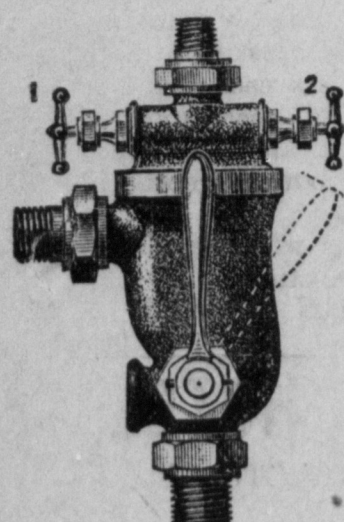

To Measure Land Quickly.
