Lobsters are Cannibals.

One hundred millions of baby lobsters will be hatched artificially by the United States Fish Commission during the coming summer.

The eggs are obtained from fishermen, who bring the female lobsters to the Government station at Wood's Hole, Mass. One fair-sized lobster will yield 40,000 eggs.

An infant lobster looks not at all like the adult specimen. The latter walks about on the bottom of the sea, but its juvenile offspring swims near the surface of the water for the first few weeks of its life.

For a long time the Government experts have been puzzling over a problem which remains to this day unsolved. They could soon cause the waters along the Atlantic coast to swarm with lobsters if only they could discover a way of rearing these artificially hatched until they are seven weeks old and arrived at the adult stage.

But lobsters are by nature cannibals and the young ones eat each other up. It is hardly practicable to provide a separate compartment for each adolescent lobster.

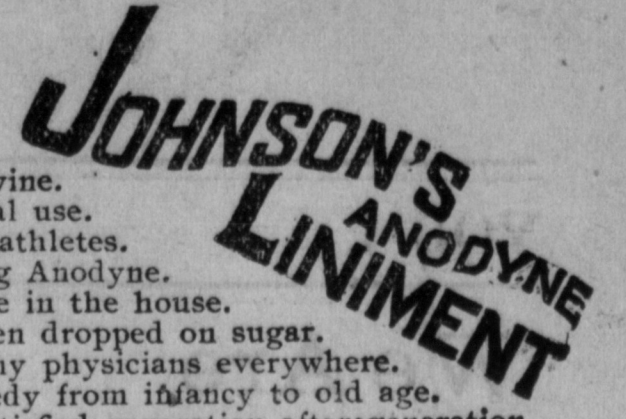

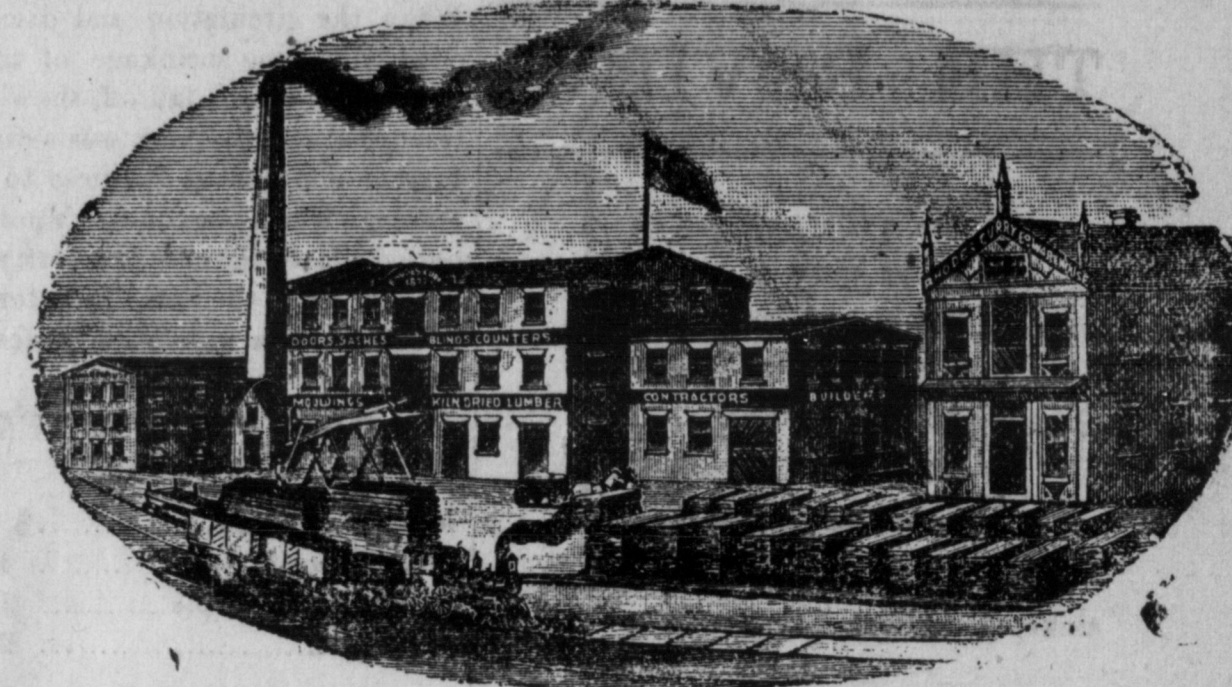
