THE POLITICAL CRISIS ENDED.

In the last issue of THE REVIEW a despatch from Ottawa announced the ending of the political crisis at the capital, and the return of the resigned ministers to their portfolios. The one exception is that Sir Charles Tupper enters the cabinet as Secretary of State, while Sir Charles Hibbert Tupper remains out.

The return of Sir Charles Tupper is in accordance with the general desire of the ministerial party, and will give increased strength and prestige. But it must not be expected that at his present advanced age of seventy-four years that he is possessed of all the vigor of twenty years ago. Sir Charles will sit in the Commons, and is seeking a seat in Cape Breton County N. S. where Mr. McKean, the sitting member has resigned to make room for him.

The recent appointment of half a dozen members of the commons to the senate, and the loss of some seats in the by-elections recently, considerably decreases the government's majority in the house. It therefore becomes of increasing interest to know how many of the ministerial party, from Ontario and the west particularly, will feel unable to vote for the remedial bill.

BRITAIN AGAINST THE WORLD.

A remarkable feature of the world's affairs recently has been the manner in which the attention of all nations has been directed toward England. This is partly due to the world-wide dispersion of her possessions and her all-embracing commerce. Her immense naval armament and the return of the Conservative party to power, with its vigorous foreign policy, completes the chain of causes.

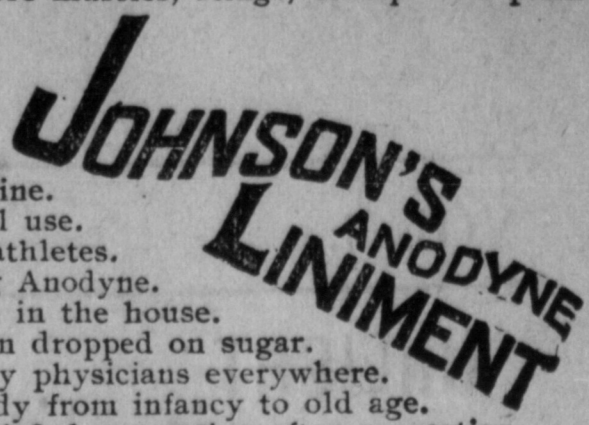

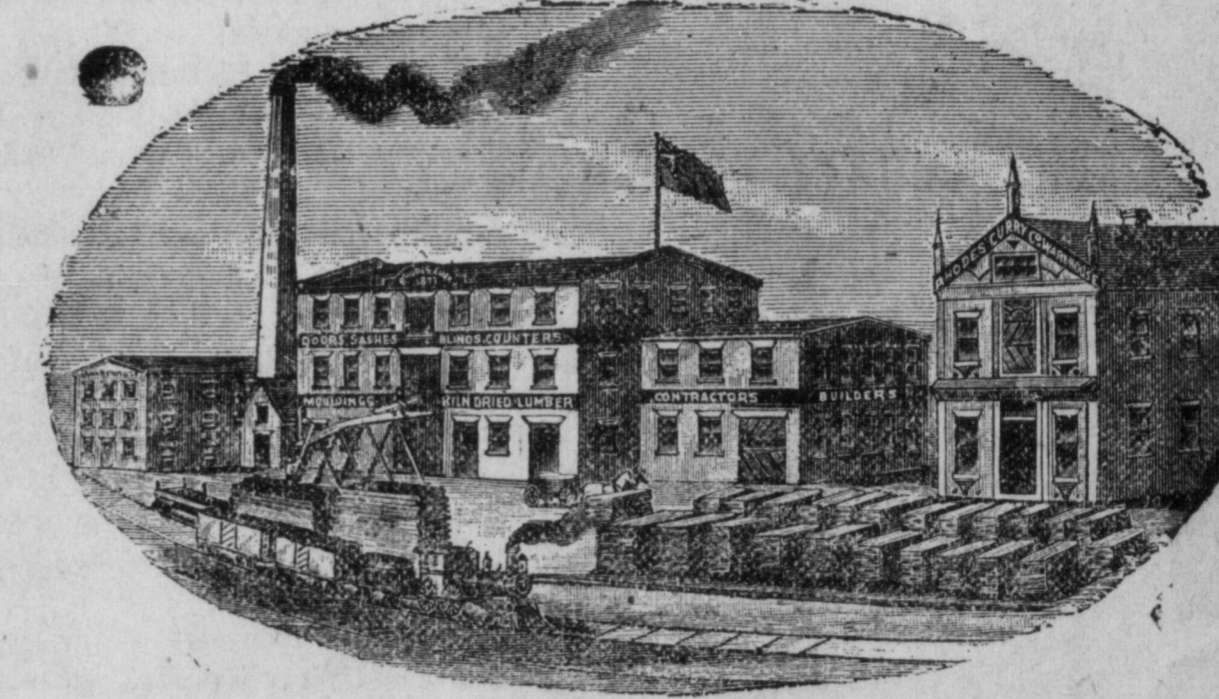
