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

A New Salt for Curing Fish.

An Inverness paper has the following item from its Stornoway correspondent with regard to a fish salt which will, it is expected, revolutionize the fish-curing trade: "No little interest was occasioned at the fish mart by the appearance of Hern M. Stare, of Charlteenburg, Germany, who came to Stornoway to introduce a fish salt which, in his estimation, is to revolutionize the fish-curing business. He claims that fish treated with this salt can be kep for an indefinite period-say for month -in a perfectly fresh condition. He also maintains that this salt is capable of curing the fish with the addition of a little ordinary salt. During his stay he purchased some herrings and put them up in small tarrels and treated them with his preparation. Mr. Stare returned to Ger many a few weeks ago, but left these barrels to be examined in the course of a month or two, with a view of proving the efficacy of his preparation. He also let samples of the salt in the hands of various curers in town." The opening of the barrels will be waited for with interest, as, if the sait comes up to expectations, it wi! mean the beginning of a new era in the fish curing trades.

Kite Photographs of Boston,

William A. Eddy, of Bayonne, N. J., has succeeded in making several distinct photographic views of Boston from a great height, by means of a camera supported from kites. The kites were of the tailless type used at the Blue Hill Observatory where an altitude of 7.441 feet was obtained, and were six and seven feet in diameter. Four to eight of these kites were required to support the camera, depending upon the strength of the wind. Distinct views were obtained of the Common. Beacon Street, Commonwealth Avenue, Charles River, and the outlying suburbs, and Mr. Eddy estimates that in one of the views the camera was, at the moment of exposure, 1,500 feet above the pavement.
