

On the day when the three Montreal firemen who lost their lives while on duty were buried, the Star acknowledged subscriptions amounting to \$1,600 for their families. Half of this money was contributed by the local banks.

Thousands of bicyclists all over the world will watch with interest the outcome of the claim filed with the Turkish government by United States Minister Terrell for \$40,000 damages for the murder in 1895 of the Pittsburgh bicyclist, Frank Lenz, in Asiatic Turkey by Kurds. The claim is made by the mother of Lenz, and will, of course, be pressed by the American government. It will be remembered that Lenz was making a bicycle tour of the world for *Outing* when he met his cruel death.

The U. S. grand jury is still considering the Herbert Fuller murder case. Lester Monks, who was a passenger on board the barkentine at the time of the murder, occupied several hours in giving his testimony. Steward Spencer also told his story, and several of the crew were called.

Edward Rogers, a Canadian wood chopper, charged with the murder of Timothy L. Parnallee at Cobalt Conn., on the night of February 26 was found guilty of murder in the second degree and was sentenced by Judge Elmer to the state prison at Wethersfield for life.
