

AIKEN, S. C., Oct. 28 .- A party of six Brant Stanley and Hierss, took Isom home in Colleton County one night last December and dragged them several miles behind a buggy to Broxton Bridge, in a lonely swamp.

The lynchers were tried in Walterboro the county seat of Colleton last February for the murder of Hanna Walker and to the surprise of the entire state were ac quitted. Solicitor Bellinger had done his nest to secure a conviction and mortally offended the numerous and influential friends of the defendants, who tried hard and unsuccessfully to prevent his re-elec tion this summer.

Solicitor Bellinger was shrewed enough to try the defendants on only one indictment at Walterboro. He afterwards secured a change of venue to Aiken for the trial on the charge of murdering Isom Kearse, and the trial has commenced there. Solicitor Bellinger conducts the state's case alone, while seven of the leading lawvers of the circuit represent the defen-

The case will hardly go to the jury before Saturday. There are over eighty witnesses summoned. The testimony shows that the victims came to their death from flogging inflicted by the defendants. The medical testimony showed the flogging to have been simply unmercitul, so severe as to pulpify the muscles of the arms and backs of the victims. The entire state is watching the trial with great interest.






