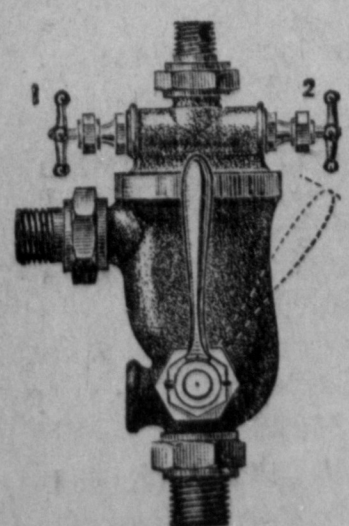

### Their Bad Policy.

BUFFALO, May 14.—Under the head of "Trade with Canada" the *Courier-Record* this morning says editorially:

"We have been furnishing our Canadian cousins with about one-half their imports. We have found them good pay. Uncle Sam needs their trade quite as badly as does that opulent shop-keeper, John Bull. We have therefore sent 60 per cent. more goods to Canada yearly than has Great Britain. Our proximity to Canada and other causes have had a constantly increasing tendency to kill British 'competition. In 1889 Great Britain exported to Canada more products than did the United States. In 1890 the exports from the two countries were about equal in value. During the last seven years the United States has been steadily getting the business away from Great Britain. Our exports to Canada are of the value of \$50,000,000 annually. British exports amount to \$30,000,000. We purchase Canadian products to the value of \$30,000,000 each year, while the English purchase \$50,000,000 worth. Thus it appears that the mother country has every claim which reciprocal patronage confers to the import trade of Canada. It was offered to us and we refused it. Thus at a single stroke we exclude ourselves from a foreign market of sale for our goods, relying upon an inadequate home market to consume them and bar ourselves from a foreign market of purchase."

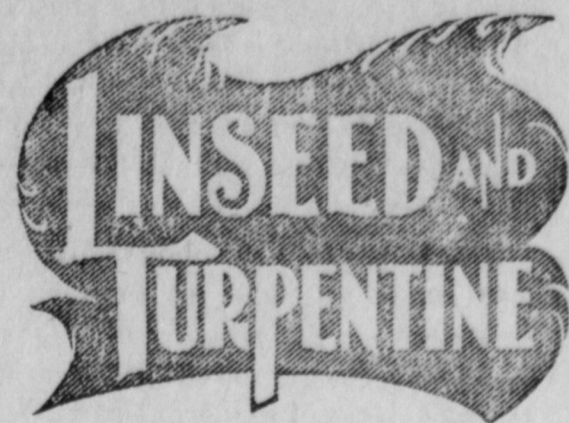

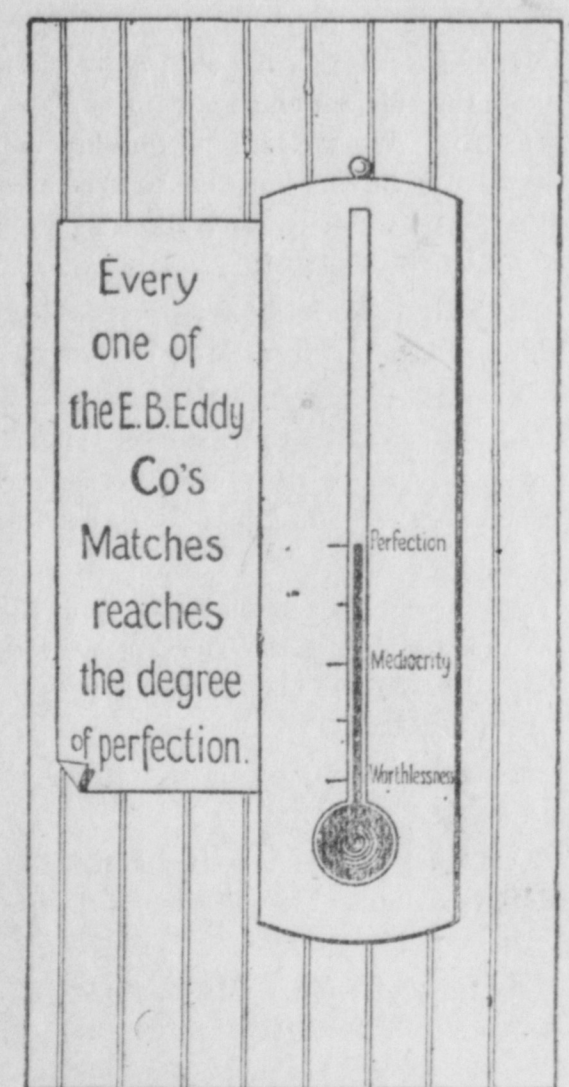
