Table with 3 columns: Mare or Gelding 4 yrs old and upwards draught, Mare or Gelding 4 yrs, Mare or Gelding 3, etc.

Class 4. Pure Breed Cattle

Table with 3 columns: Ayrshire Bull 1 yr old, Cow, Heifer 2, etc.

Class 5 Grade Cattle

Table with 3 columns: Milch Cow Best, Heifer 2 years old, Heifer 1.

Table with 3 columns: Calf, Steer 3 years old, etc.

Class 6. Sheep

Table with 3 columns: Ewe 2 years old and upwards, Lamb, Ram.

Table with 3 columns: Boar Pig 1 year old and upwards, this springs, Sow Bre'd this spring.

Class 8. Farm Produce
