MAY BE MUELLER.

JAMES BURDEN MAY BE PAID THE \$500 REWARD FOR THE APPREHENSION OF A MURDERER.

(Fredericton Gleaner.)

A few weeks ago the Gleaner published an account of the visits to this city of James E. Burden of Worcester, Mass., in We met t'other night in the district, en the interests of justice and looking for a murderer named Paul Mueller, and who was believed by Mr. Burden and others to be none other than William Barry, who was then working with Isaac Burden, the tailor. Barry's subsequent and peculiar and suspicious actions were related and his subsequent leaving for Melbourne, Australia, upon a sailing vessel, which left St. John in the early part of August.

The Worcester Telegram of Oct. 3rd

Warren E. Tarbell, deputy sheriff, returned to-night with a photograph of Paul Mueller, the suspect seen in Frederictoo, N. B., in August, by James E. Burden of Worcester, which he obtained from State Detective Peleg F. Murray. Mr. Tarbell says the face is the same as Mueller's, and he will go to-morrow to Rice's Corner to show it to neighbors who knew Mueller.

If his suspicions are confirmed, be and Detective Murray will take steps to have the suspect extradited from Melbourne, Australia, on a charge of murdering Francis D. Newton, wife, and their daughter, Elsie, in Brookfield, the night of Jan. 7, 1898.

The suspect is on his way from St. John, N. B., to Melbourne, in the ship Toppet, and it can easily be arranged to have him arrested when the vessel reaches that port.

Mr. Burden, who saw him in Fredericton and secured the photograph for the officers, will probably be paid the \$500 offered by the town of Brookfield for his
