Public feeling over the Reid arbitration difficulty is growing more intense. A member of the government says: "The solvent existence of the colony depends upon the outcome of this arbitration. The government is prepared to exhaust every legitimate expediency to insure the absolute impartiality of the arbitration tribunal." The colonial government has protested against the appointment by Supreme Court Justice Emerson and Sir Sandford Fleming, of Ottawa, owing to his reputed connection with Canadian railroad interests. Mr. Reid, who is a railroad contractor, has a claim against Newfoundland for \$2,000,000. The Supreme Court did not appoint a third arbitrator.
