A good deal of anxiety has been manifested during the week, on account of the various reports in circula-tion of the nature of the disease on board the Terry, now performing quarantine. The following report of the Health Officers, is highly satisfactory, and will tend to remove all apprehension of contagion. Much credit is due to the Magistrates for the rigorous manner in which they have inforced the quarantine Regulations.

THIS IS TO CERTIFY, that we examined the Passen-gers on board the brig Ferry. That shortly after leav-ing Dublin, a disease broke out, similar to Cholera, of which ten died; that several are now labouring un-der slight affections of the bowels, which might be at-tributed in a great degree (if not altogether) to crowd-ing, filth, and want of nourishment; in which opinion we are the more confirmed by observing the rapid im-provement that has taken place in a few days (without provement that has taken place in a few days (without medicine) since their diet has been increased, and cleanliness more attended to.
