Most of the play was on the St. John 25 yard line until Goodspeed went over for a try about 15 minutes after the period opened. The angle was very difficult, and Babbitt failed to convert. Fredericton failed to score again, owing to the hard tacking and scrim work of the St. John boys, and the period ended 3—0 in favor of F. H. S.

The St. John boys received another set back when, after four minutes play, the F. H. S. halves secured the ball and Simpson crossed the line, Babbitt failing to convert from a difficult angle.

From the kick-off the ball was carried into F. H. S. territory and play was about evenly divided between the two teams until Linton secured his try. It was unconverted, and the game ended with the play within St. John territory and the score 6—3, in favor of F. H. S.

This was one of the hardest contested games played between the two schools in recent years, and the first time Fredericton was ever scored on at the Trotting Park field.
