## EDITORIAL



This year the High School term began in the High School with an attendance of over 400 pupils.

The new High School provides for three courses: Academic, Commercial, and Pre-Vocational. Two hundred and ninety-six pupils are enrolled in the Academic course, which includes Latin, Greek or French, Geometry, Algebra, Arithmetic, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Physiology, Literature, Grammar, Essay Writing, and History. The Commercial department was first opened in January, 1922, and from that time the attendance has increased from 15 to 63, thirty-seven of whom are in Grade IX. The course embraces Grammar, Literature, Composition, History, Arithmetic, Rapid Calculation, Bookkeeping, Shorthand, Typewriting, Correspondence, Penmanship, Spelling, Filing and Commercial Geography and Law. It prepares students to fill stenographical and secretarial positions.
